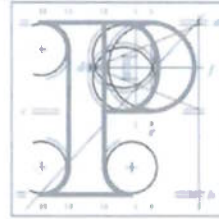

A Chara,

I wish to acknowledge receipt of correspondence from you dated 6th February 2026, notifying Cork City Council that An Coimisiún Pleanála has received an application for permission under section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.

It is noted that this application was made to the Commission on 5th December 2025. It is further noted that the local authority has a period of 10 weeks (plus 9 days for Christmas) from the making of the application to the Commission, to prepare a report, present to Council and submit to the Commission.

As An Coimisiún Pleanála failed to notify Cork City Council of the receipt of this application in a timely manner, it is hereby requested that Cork City Council be afforded an appropriate timeframe to consider and review the application, to prepare a report and present to Council prior to submission. Therefore, we respectfully request an additional period of 9 weeks from the date of notification to carry out our statutory duties with regard to this application. This 9-week timeframe represents the period that passed before Cork City Council received notification of the application.

Furthermore, I wish to request a hard copy of the application, as Cork City Council is obliged to make a hard copy of this application available to the public and has not yet received a copy of same.
