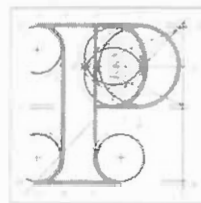

Accordingly, any observations or response in relation to the proposed development should be received by the Commission not later than 4 weeks from the date of this request i.e. **on or before 20<sup>th</sup> April 2026.**
