


The Commission will revert to you in due course with regard to the matter.

- A. Proposed 5,000 tonnes of hazardous waste, there is no description of what the hazardous waste is. Please clarify.
- B. I like on occasion to fly fish the river Nanny, I would like some reassurance that the disturbance on the Knockharley river will not affect or kill the fish in the Nanny. I noted from the Inspectors report in relation to the changes that there was no input either delivered or requested in relation to this point. There does not appear to be any advice sought from the inland fisheries or notifications to the fly-fishing club in Duleek.
- C. The community liaison committee should be kept in its current form for the lifetime of the landfill.
- D. The system to establish the community fund should be the net weight per tonne across the weigh bridge. The system to establish the cost per tonne I have checked with the central bank to give me an assessment for inflation since 2009 (€1.89 per tonne). 2026 the inflation rate brings it up to €3.20 per tonne.
- E. Both points on C and D should be included in the planning permission sought to protect the community.
