I have been asked by An Coimisiún Pleanála to refer further to the above-mentioned case.

It is a statutory objective of the Commission to ensure that every application received is determined within 18 weeks beginning on the last date for making objections, observations, or submissions. This is in accordance with section 37J(2)(a) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. Where it appears to the Commission that it would not be possible or appropriate to determine a particular application within this period, a notice must be sent to the parties in accordance with section 37J(3) of the 2000 Act, as amended.

The Commission hereby serves notice under section 37J(3) that it will not be possible to determine the case within the statutory objective period due to the need for further consideration of the case. The Commission regrets the delay in determining this case.

The Commission intends to determine this application before 2nd July 2027. The Commission will take all such steps as are open to it to ensure that the matter is determined before that date.

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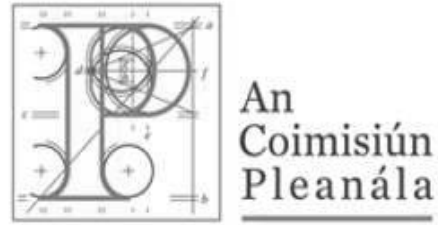
