

SHANNON to DUBLIN WATER SUPPLY PROJECT (Ref. PA92.323980)

I Liam Minehan a CPO land owner, formally object to the Proposed Water Supply Project for the Eastern and Midlands Region. I plead with the people in planning who have this decision to make to look at The proposal which involves turning off the power production in Ardnacrusha to maintain water supply to Dublin, while electricity production in continued in Blessington because 70% of the water Poulaphouca is allocated to the EBS, if this was reversed there no need for this pipeline, no need for the environmental destruction of the Shannon River and the Fact that there will be no water available for any future water intensive industries in the Shannon region. This project was propose 30 years ago, at no stage has it made since, but no one has cried halt, the drought of 2018 highlights the environmental risks , the Kennedy report Highlights the economics risks the quality of water can only be improved by stopping water ingress and the leaks. Dublin water supply can be solved by incrementally adding ESB water from Poulaplouca and use the money to fix leaks.
