

Hereby object to the Compulsory accusation of my lands at The Pass, Coagh Upper and Kiltubrid Island by uisce eireann for the proposed water supply project eastern and midlands region. The following are my grounds for objection,

Uisce eireann has failed to follow procedure in that no written notice of planning application or compulsory purchase order has being served on myself Mark Kinsella

This acquisition of between 50 to 100 metre wide strip of land to construct a 1.5 meter diameter pipeline is a disproportionate interference and destruction of of a highly productive farm.

The project is unjustified in that over 50% of treated water in Dublin is lost true leakage. This is environmentally unsustainable in the present day.
