

The measures as presented to us represent an enormous improvement in safety and are very much welcomed and supported by my constituents. They are specifically pleased with;


- Provision of dedicated footpaths
- Cycle lane
- The foot/cycle bridge allowing connectivity at the most dangerous point
- Improved sight lines at the junctions along the route
- Reinstatement of the embankment

I wish to commend the authorities for taking on board many concerns expressed following the initial consultation phase and ensuring as far as possible that these concerns were addressed.

I also note extensive consultations over the years with the authority and Waterville House and Golf Links. The location of the Pedestrian Bridge is of concern to them, and I welcome the softening of the design from 2018 to this version. I thank them for having exhausted all alternative options in their efforts to progress the project.
