SUBJECT: WEXFORD COUNTY COUNCIL COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER NO. 01 OF 2026 IN THE COUNTY OF WEXFORD. LAND/BUILDINGS AT 6/7 CASTLE STREET, ENNISCORTHY URBAN, COUNTY WEXFORD.

ORDER: By virtue of the powers, function and duties vested in me by the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT.....

on the recommendation of the Director of Services for Economic Development, Planning and Property Management, approval be given to the Compulsory Acquisition of land/buildings at 6/7 Castle Street, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford for the purposes of the Local Authority's functions and to facilitate the development of The Castle Heritage Quarter package of The Enniscorthy Town Centre First Plan (2023) and whereas the parcels of land/buildings required cannot be purchased by agreement and whereas it is considered convenient to effect the acquisition of such parcels of land/buildings under Section 76 of and the Third Schedule to the Housing Act 1966, Section 10 of the Local Government (No.2) Act, 1960 as substituted by Section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966 together with such amendments, extensions, provisions and substitutions regarding the making of compulsory purchase orders provided under the Planning and Development Act 2000 – 2017, the Local Government (No 2) Act 1960, Section 10 of the Local Government (Ireland) Act 1898, Section 11 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act 1960, Section 6 of the second schedule to the Roads Act, 1993, Section 47 of the Roads Act 1993 as amended by the Roads (Amendment) Act 1998 and by the Roads Act 2007 and Section 213 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, the acquisition of the parcels of land/buildings be so effected and a compulsory purchase order be prepared under the above Acts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT

- i. That the Official Seal of the Council is to be affixed to the Wexford County Council Compulsory Order No 01 of 2026 in the County of Wexford and to the map and schedules referred to therein, and
- ii. That the Compulsory Purchase Order and relevant maps be submitted to An Bord Pleanála (An Coimisiún Pleanála) for confirmation in accordance with Section 76 of the Third Schedule to the Housing Act 1966 as amended, and
- iii. The Notice of the making of the Compulsory Purchase Order be published and served in accordance with Article 4(a) of the Third Schedule to the Housing Act 1966, as amended by the Planning & Development Acts 2000 – 2017.
