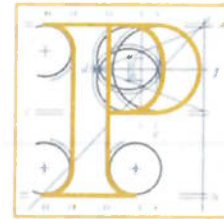

Re: Proposed alterations to the previously permitted 110 kV substation with Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) technology and two 110 kV underground transmission cables
Located within the townlands of Bogland, Kish, Cooladangan, Ballintombay, Ballyroonaun, and Ballynattin, Co. Wicklow.

Dear Sir / Madam,

An Coimisiún Pleanála refers further to your request in accordance with section 146B of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to alter the terms of the previously permitted 110 kV substation with Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) technology and two 110kV underground transmission cables located within the townlands of Bogland and other townlands, Co. Wicklow

Please be advised that the Commission has decided, in accordance with section 146B(2)(a) of the Act, that the proposed alteration would constitute a material alteration to the terms of the development.

Before making a determination under section 146B(3)(b) or section 146B(4) of the Act, the Commission has decided to invoke the provisions of section 146B(8) of the Act, and, accordingly, requires you to carry out the following:

- (i) Deposit a copy of the information relating to the request with the planning authority requesting that it be made available for inspection or for purchase, upon payment of a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy (the request will also be available for inspection and purchase at the offices of the An Coimisiún Pleanála);
- (ii) Send notice of the request, and a copy of the request, to the prescribed bodies listed on the attached document, stating that submissions or observations may be made in writing to the Commission before a specified date;
- (iii) Publish in two newspapers circulating in the area in which the development is located, a notice stating that a request to alter the terms of the development has been made to An Coimisiún Pleanála under section 146B of the Act, that the request will be available for inspection or for purchase, upon payment of a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the request may be made in writing to the Commission before a specified date.

In respect of (iii) above, the notices should be published in two newspapers, one of which should be a national newspaper. In respect of the time limits for the making of submissions or observations in

relation to the request to the Commission, the specified time period shall be not less than four weeks. Please see draft public notice attached.

You are also requested to erect site notices at the same locations where the site notices for the application were erected and at appropriate locations to reflect the proposed alterations (if relevant). The site notice should be signed and the date of the erection of the notice is to be inserted; otherwise it should contain the same information as the draft public notice attached.

You should submit the relevant newspaper notices and a copy of the notices issued under (ii) above to the Commission as soon as same are available. In this regard you are requested to submit 2 hard copies and 1 electronic copy of the documentation. Your response to this letter should be received by the Commission no later than **26th of June 2026**.

The information relating to the proposed alteration (including the details of the request) may be inspected on payment of a specified fee at the offices of ***** County Council and the offices of An Coimisiún Pleanála during public opening hours for a period of xxx weeks commencing on the XXXXXXXXXXXX.

Any submissions/observations in relation to the request to alter the terms of the development may be made to An Coimisiún Pleanála, (the Commission), 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 or online at online.pleanala.ie/en. Any submission must be accompanied by a fee of €50, except for certain prescribed bodies. There is no charge for a submission/observation by those parties/individuals who have already made a valid submission/observation to the Commission in relation to the original application (reference number ABP-*****).

Submissions/observations must be received by the Commission **no later than the XXXXXXXX**. All submissions/observations must include the following:

- (i) the name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on their behalf, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent;
- (ii) the subject matter of the submission or observation, and
- (iii) the reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based.

Any submissions or observations which do not comply with the above requirements cannot be considered by the Commission.
