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Hi Niamh,

As requested in the call yesterday, please see below the latest project description (subject to change but it should be quite similar):

A summary of the proposed project is as follows:

- 13 no. wind turbines with a blade tip height of 150 m, a rotor diameter of 136 m, a hub height of 82 m, and all associated foundations and hard-standing areas in respect of each turbine;
- Creation of two new site entrances onto the R334 Regional Road;
- Construction of two temporary construction compounds with associated temporary site offices, parking areas and security fencing;
- One borrow pit. All works associated with the opening, aggregate and spoil extraction, and decommissioning of the borrow pit;
- Construction of new internal site access tracks, to include passing bays and all associated drainage;
- Construction of a temporary new access track to connect to the adjacent operating quarry;
- Construction of drainage and sediment control systems;
- Construction of new on-site control building
- Construction of one permanent loop-in 110 kV electrical substation compound including
 - o One control building containing worker welfare facilities;
 - o Electrical infrastructure and grid ancillary services equipment
 - o Parking
 - o Lighting
 - o Fencing
 - o Wastewater holding tank
 - o Rainwater harvesting equipment
 - o Communications equipment and storage
 - o Associated electrical plant
 - o All associated infrastructure, services, and site works including landscaping
- All works associated with the connection of the proposed wind farm to the proposed 110 kV loop-in substation, which will be via 33 kV underground cable connection, including 4 no. watercourse crossings, and the onward connection from the substation to the existing overhead line via 110kV cables and steel lattice interface masts;

- All associated underground electrical and communications cabling connecting the wind turbines to the proposed wind farm control building;
- All associated infrastructure and services including site works and signage;
- Construction of a lidar unit, and associated foundation and hard-standing area;
- All related site works and ancillary development including site drainage, security gates, fencing, permanent and temporary signage, berms, landscaping, soil excavation and biodiversity mitigation and enhancements, including hedgerow and tree planting;
- Works required at one location along the public road network to accommodate delivery of oversize/abnormal turbine components in addition to temporary demounting of signage and vegetation trimming at other locations.

I have also attached a figure of the proposed wind farm site layout and the proposed GCR (to the proposed 110 kV substation which will loop into the adjacent overhead line) as mentioned. If you need anything else please let me know.
