Development Location

Cahermurphy, Knocknahila More South, Carrownagry South, Caheraghcullin and Drummin, Co. Clare.

Development Description

Proposed windfarm development located at Cahermurphy and adjacent townlands, located in Co. Clare, including 8 No. turbines with a limited tip height range of 180 metres to 185 metres and all associated foundations and hardstanding areas, access roads and entrance(s) including upgrade of existing site roads and provision of new roads, 110kV electrical substation and wind farm control building, underground cabling, 2 no. borrow pits, electrical cabling for 110kV grid connection, biodiversity enhancement areas, 2 no. temporary construction compounds, peat and spoil management and a permanent meteorological mast.

A Chara,

As the National Water Utility Uisce Éireann delivers water services pursuant to the Water Services Act (and other legislation) and in accordance with our statutory functions and ancillary responsibilities and in a manner which is consistent with public policy.

Uisce Éireann is responsible for the delivery of all public water and wastewater services in Ireland. We are committed to continuously upgrading and developing critical infrastructure to support growth in our economy, while protecting the environment and safeguarding water supplies. Connection(s) to Public Water and Wastewater

No new connections to Uisce Éireann's water and wastewater networks are included in the applicant's proposal. Water for sanitary use at site facilities is envisaged to be supplied by harvested rainwater. Wastewater is to be stored in stored in foul water holding tanks, and to be emptied by private contractors as need arises.

Protection of Existing Uisce Eireann's Assets

Uisce Éireann does not operate any infrastructure in the vicinity of the development, as such no impact to its assets is anticipated.

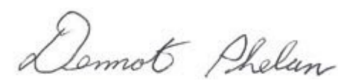
Protection of Existing Public Watter Supply

It is Uisce Éireann's policy to maintain safe and secure drinking water supplies and ensure that development will not give rise to any deterioration in water quality and that development proposals shall not impact public drinking water sources and/or abstraction point(s).

While Uisce Éireann operates a drinking water abstraction point at the nearby Lough Doo, located approximately 15000 meters from several of the Hen Harrier enhancement land parcels which comprise a part of this application. Uisce Éireann acknowledges and is satisfied with the conclusion of the applicants Water Framework Directive compliance chapter that the proposed project does not involve any abstraction of groundwater or alteration of drainage patterns.
