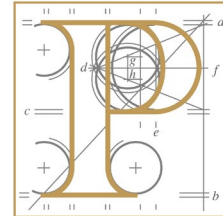

Any observations to the Commission should be made within **4 weeks** of the date of this letter. Your response should be made to the Commission on or before the **26th August 2026**. Please note that An Coimisiún Pleanála following its consideration of the application can decide to:

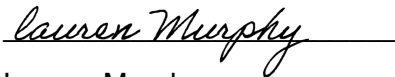
- (a)(i) grant the permission/approval, or
- (ii) make such modifications to the proposed development as it specifies in its decision and grant permission/approval in respect of the proposed development as so modified, or

(iii) grant permission/approval in respect of part of the proposed development (with or without specified modifications of it of the foregoing kind), and any of the above decisions may be subject to or without conditions or

(b) refuse to grant the permission/approval.
