Please note that An Coimisiún Pleanála following its consideration of the application can decide to:

- (ii) make such modifications to the proposed development as it specifies in its decision and grant permission/ approval with regard to the proposed development as so modified, or
- (iii) grant permission/approval with regard to part of the proposed development (with or without specified modifications of it of the foregoing kind), and any of the above decisions may be subject to or without conditions, or

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(b) refuse to grant the permission/approval.

Any observations to the Commission should be made within 4 weeks of the date of this letter. Your response should be made to the Commission on or before the 23rd July 2026.
