A Chara,

We refer to your letters of 10th June last. In particular your request as follows:

The Commission also invites you to consider any legislation, or policies, or guidelines, development plans or local area plans, including European Union Habitats (Lower River Suir SAC 002137) Regulations 2024, that have come into effect since the original application was submitted, and outline how the application responds to the same, or submit additional information in response to any such updates. In particular, a response to the Water Framework Directive in respect of Skelpstown Stream and the River Suir waterbodies should be submitted.

Having regard, inter alia, to the fact that the application for confirmation of the CPO and development consent commenced in 2022, the legal proceedings including the issues raised therein, and the requirement for updated information to be provided, the Council hereby requests an extension of time **up to 30 November 2026** in circumstances where the Council is appointing Consultants to review the relevant information, to carry out such surveys as are required and to collate the information in order to fully meet your request.
