Submitted Details Report dated the 6th day of February, 2026 from Pat Shore, Town Regeneration Officer, Meath County Council, recommending that a Compulsory Purchase Order be made to acquire the property.

Order Details By the powers conferred on me under Section 151 of the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended by the Local Government Reform Act, 2014, I hereby order as follows:

- i. That the lands, as referred to above and detailed in the Schedule attached to the report and accompanying maps be acquired compulsorily.
- ii. That a Compulsory Purchase Order as aforesaid be prepared in the prescribed form and once prepared that the Official Seal of the Council is to be affixed to the Compulsory Purchase Order and relevant maps.
- iii. That the Notice of the making of the Compulsory Purchase Order be published and served in accordance with Article 4(a) of the Third Schedule to the Housing Act 1966, as amended by the Planning & Development Acts 2000 - 2023.
- iv. That the Compulsory Purchase Order and relevant maps be submitted to An Coimisiun Pleanála for confirmation in accordance with Section 76 of the Third Schedule to the Housing Act 1966 as amended.
