We, Rosalind Callander and Michael Callander resident at the above address write to state our objections to the above numbered application.

The following issues justify a refusal of permission for this proposed development:

CONSULTATION

There has been little or no consultation with people in this area.

RESIDENTIAL AND PROPERTY IMPACT

The proposed turbines are uncomfortably close to existing homes.

The visual impact, noise pollution and potential shadow flicker will significantly disrupt the quality of life and amenity of residents and could impact on their physical and mental health.

The area in question also includes a specially designed sensory garden for children and those people with disabilities.

Property is also likely to be devalued with no prospect of borrowing money against their houses. Planning permission for future development is also likely to be denied.

IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT, ECOLOGY AND ARCHAEOLOGY

The area in question consists of blanket bog and areas with ecological significance under the Habitats Directive.

The large volume of peat to be extracted and the disturbance/destruction to the habitats will have serious and long term detrimental effects on biodiversity and peatland restoration.

The area is home to the protected Hen Harrier and this development will result in the permanent loss of its habitat.

The area also forms part of the historic Ceide Fields Complex – we fail to see how this can be preserved with the sheer size and scale of this proposed development.

TRAFFIC AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

The construction phase will bring unacceptable disruption to the local road network including past the local secondary school at Lacken Cross. The road safety issues have not been adequately addressed in the proposal.

SITE SUITABILITY AND LANDSCAPE IMPACT

The area which is the subject of this proposal is one of the most beautiful and unique parts of County Mayo. Turbines will have a negative impact on this landscape as they will be seen for many miles and indeed from other counties. We understand Mayo County Council agree with this and will be opposing the application.

TOURISM

Failte Ireland have recently unveiled a proposal for increasing visitor numbers to the area including a Ceide Coastal Walk taking in the coast from Ceide Fields to Downpatrick Head. Failte Ireland has previously commented on the major visual disturbance of turbines in this area (Glenora WF PA16.318701) which will only be exacerbated if this development is allowed to proceed.

We enclose a map "Ceide Coast, North Mayo Tourism Map and Guide" which was produced in 2014 by ourselves and a few others to promote this part of North Mayo. It was financed by donations from local businesses and reprinted with the aid of Mayo Councillors in 2018. To date thirty thousand copies have been distributed and shows the level of commitment to tourism in this area

and also shows all the historical sites and activities in the area the subject of this application.

OUR CONCLUSION

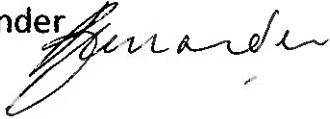
If this development is allowed to proceed then the area will be changed in all aspects for generations. The effect on us all will be irreversible and even more unacceptable as the technology is already out of date.

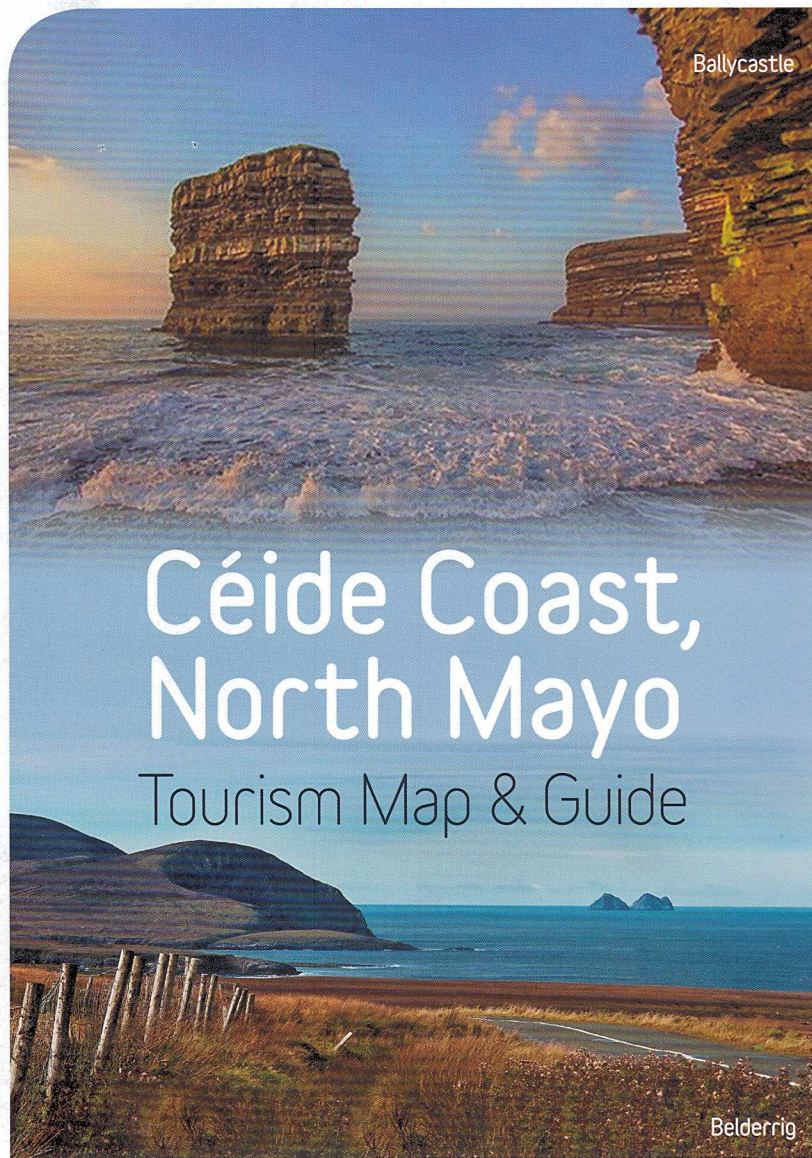

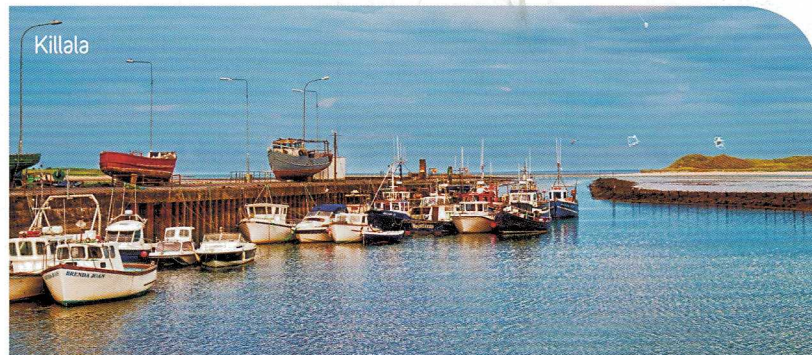
