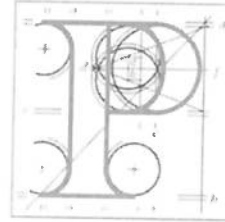

We are acting on behalf of Catherine Coll.

We are objecting to this case on a technical basis. Our client's in principal are not objecting to the scheme. There is an obligation on the acquiring authority to properly establish the facts. In respect of chapter 15 material assets/ agriculture the impact on the farming activity is described as moderate. In circumstances where 19% of the land is taken and access to other lands is made more difficult, we consider the impact is severe to major

As per design drawing, we consider access to the residential property is seriously compromised or closed off which is not acceptable.

The inclusion of an active travel path on this overall scheme is an act of delusion by the overall acquiring authority and State and it is beyond us why anyone would want to walk beside a national road. The access to the travel path is seriously compromising the residential entrance
