Description of proposed development: 10 year planning permission for Lissinagroagh Wind Farm consisting of 14 no. wind turbines and all associated infrastructure.

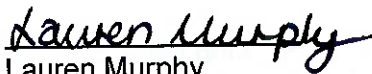
