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Dear Sir/Madam,

I am contacting you on behalf of our Client, FuturEnergy Ireland Development DAC, to make a pre-application consultation request under Section 182E of the Planning and Development Act 2000, (as amended) in respect of the Proposed Lettermore Long Duration Energy Storage Development, County Donegal. The Proposed Development includes an 'under the fence' (UTF) transformer compound adjacent to the existing Drumkeen 110 kV network sub-station. The transformer compound is required to enable the connection of the LDES Facility to the national grid. The Drumkeen 110kV Substation will also require works to accommodate the UTF connection to the LDES Facility (note these works are only to facilitate this connection).

This consultation request relates to the UTF Transformer Compound and Substation works only because this is the only part of the Proposed Development that includes 110kV electrical infrastructure. The remainder of the Project shall comprise medium or low voltage electrical infrastructure.
