We are lodging an official objection to the proposed windfarm in
Muningmore Erris Co Mayo.

I was born and raised in Dooyork and am very proud of this.

Even though I no longer live in Dooyork, my parents and siblings live there.

My husband, children and I return to the area at least once a month.

We love returning home and hope to retire here some day.

We strongly object to the above wind farm for the following reasons:

1. We believe that the proposed development would destroy the environmental, heritage and peaceful nature of this area. The peace and tranquility of the area is fundamental to our health and well being. There is nothing nicer than walking the many beautiful beaches in the area and breathing in its fresh sea air.
2. The proposed windfarm is enormous and their height would destroy the natural beautiful landscape and skyline of this area forever. These structures would be visible for miles in every direction. Once developed these natural views can not be replaced. Our beautiful dark skies will be replaced with flashing/flickering lights.

3. The proposed windfarms would undoubtedly create noise which is concerning especially for my families mental health and well being. Wind turbine noise, especially low frequency sound has been proven to disrupt sleep and concentration levels adding to mental health and well being. The negative effect on health has been well documented in this country for many years.
4. We believe the proposed wind farms will restrict planning permission in the area. As this is an area we would eventually like to return to, this is of great concern. This may impact our children in the future where they will not be granted planning permission due to zoning and visual impact policies.
5. There would be a negative impact on tourism in the area. People flock to Erris for its peace, unspoilt landscape, beautiful outdoor spaces and amenities. This would be destroyed with the development of wind farms. Many local businesses rely on tourism in the area which would be detrimental to their livelihoods.
6. We also need to consider the impact of this development on future generations to come, something I do not think has been given sufficient consideration.

Therefore we respectfully ask that our concerns are taken into account as I do believe that potential damage far outweighs any potential benefits of this development.
