We are Caroline and David Lally, and we live at Bunnawillian. We are making an observation on the proposed Muingmore Wind Farm.

This is our home. It is also our children's home and their future. We love the tranquillity and beauty of this area.

The turbines are highly visible and will change the landscape and coastline. They look unattractive and out of character. We are concerned about seeing these structures looking over people's homes.

We live on the Wild Atlantic Way and depend on tourists coming into the area. The damage to tourism will be significant.

My husband wears hearing aids and will not be able to go outside as the hearing aids do not accommodate the noise from these turbines. This will affect people's mental and physical health.

I enjoy gardening and find it peaceful listening to the birds and wildlife I have grown up with. Will I continue to be able to enjoy this? We have Eurasian wren, Barn swallow, Eurasian blackbird, and

the Eurasian Linnet here, and these will be destroyed. The construction of roads and power lines will disturb our fragile habitat.

Will the wind farm provide enough energy to the area to justify what it will do here?

These turbines will be around 1,300 meters away from our home. I am worried about the value of my home and the health issues that we and my family will have to endure.

This is my home, my children's home, and their future. I am asking that this is properly considered before any decision is made.

For the reasons set out above, we respectfully request that An Coimisiún Pleanála refuse permission for the proposed Muingmore Wind Farm development.
