I am Colm Leneghan, and I live at Muingtrenia, Geesala. I am making an observation on the proposed Muingmore Wind Farm.

The noise will affect me personally as the turbines are close to my home. I currently run a Bed and Breakfast, and when guests see that there is a wind turbine out my front door, my business will collapse. This is a major source of income for me and my family, and without it, I will not survive.

I believe as my property sits within the line of the sun rise and sunset, shadow flicker will be a disaster for us living here.

My property borders close to the development, and I sit and watch the deer wander through the bush daily. This will all disappear. This will have a big effect on tourists, which will dry up, and our community desperately relies on this I have cattle who will also be affected by this development

I was born here and have lived my life here, toiling the soil with my father and building this community—not only for me but for the people around me. When I listen and study this up, I believe there could be severe health risks to the community, and there is no real advantage to the community whose lives will be affected hugely.

I am worried about the noise, the shadow flicker, the wildlife, and my property value. This is my home, and I do not want to see this natural beauty destroyed.

For the reasons set out above, I respectfully request that An Coimisiún Pleanála refuse permission for the proposed Muingmore Wind Farm development.
