Dear Inspector,

My name is Isla-Grace, and I am 14 years old. I am writing to object to the proposed wind farm development under Planning Reference PAX16.324387 / ACP-324387-26.

My grandparents have a home in Mount Jubilee in County Mayo, and it is one of the most special places in my life. My brothers, Henry, Arlo, and my sister Madison and I spend time there every year, and it has become a place full of happy memories with our family.

One of the things I love most about Mount Jubilee is how peaceful and beautiful it is. I enjoy walking with my family and friends that I have made. Watching the wildlife, listening to the birds, and seeing the hills and open countryside. It gives me a chance to switch off from everyday life and appreciate nature in a way that I cannot where I normally live.

I understand that Ireland needs renewable energy, and I believe we should do everything we can to protect our environment. However, I do not believe that every location is the right place for a development of this size. I am worried that 13 very large wind turbines, together with the other infrastructure, would permanently change the landscape and take away the sense of peace that makes Mount Jubilee so special.

I am also concerned about the impact on wildlife and the natural environment. Places like this are important because they allow people, especially young people, to experience nature and understand why it should be protected. If the landscape is changed on such a large scale, future generations may never get to experience it as I have.

My grandparents' home is where our family comes together, and I hope that one day I will be able to bring my own children there and show them the same beautiful countryside that I have grown up enjoying.

I respectfully ask An Coimisiún Pleanála to consider the impact this development would have on young people, families, the landscape, and the natural heritage of the area when making its decision.
