I wish to submit my objection to the proposed wind farm development under Planning Reference PAX16.324387 / ACP-324387-26.

I am 17 years old, and every August I visit County Mayo with my family. These holidays have been a part of my life for many years, and they have given me some of my happiest childhood memories. County Mayo is a place that means a great deal to me because of its beautiful scenery, peaceful surroundings and unique natural environment.

I understand that renewable energy is important, and I know we need to find ways to tackle climate change. However, I do not believe that this development is the right proposal for such a special and unspoilt part of Ireland.

The landscape is unlike anywhere else I have visited. The open countryside, mountains and wild Atlantic scenery are what make Mayo so memorable. I worry that the construction of 13 large wind turbines, together with the associated infrastructure, would permanently change the character of the area and take away much of what makes it so special.

I am also concerned about the potential impact on wildlife. I enjoy seeing birds and other native animals when I visit, and I hope these habitats can be protected for future generations to enjoy.

Members of my family also live in the area, and I am concerned about how this development could affect their daily lives. I hope careful consideration is given to the potential impacts of turbine noise, shadow flicker, lighting and the loss of the peaceful environment that makes this part of Mayo such a wonderful place to live and visit.

County Mayo attracts visitors because of its natural beauty and sense of tranquillity. I believe it is important to protect these qualities so that other young people and families can continue to enjoy this remarkable place in the future.

For these reasons, I respectfully ask An Coimisiún Pleanála to refuse permission for this proposal and to protect the landscape, wildlife and communities that make County Mayo so special.
