I am writing because I do not want the Muingmore Wind Farm built near my home. I have grown up walking, cycling, looking after animals and spending time outside here. It is the only home I have ever known.

The roads around Mount Jubilee are already narrow. I would not feel safe walking or cycling while large construction lorries and heavy vehicles were passing. Children use these roads too, and they should be safe for us.

I love animals and I am always looking out for birds, rabbits and other wildlife. I would hate to see the bog dug up and the places where these animals live damaged.

I am also worried about how the turbines could affect my sleep. I need to be able to sleep properly so I can get up for school and concentrate on my work. I do not want to be tired in class or unable to focus because turbines or machinery kept me awake. I should not have to worry about this. No child should.

I love going outside at night and looking at the stars. We can see them clearly from our home. Flashing red lights on huge turbines would change the night sky that I have grown up with.

I do not want turbines to become the main thing we see every day. The views around Mount Jubilee are part of my home and part of my childhood.

Young people should have a say in what happens here. Adults will make this decision, but children and teenagers like me will have to grow up beside the development and live with it for many years.

I want to keep walking, cycling and enjoying the outdoors. I want to feel safe near my home, sleep properly at night and be able to concentrate in school.
