Eoin,

I refer to your email below in relation to the proposed SID windfarm and associated development at Doolough and Muingmore, Co Mayo. In relation to the proposed development the primary concern as it relates to DCC planning authority is the Turbine Delivery Route from Killybegs port to the Leitrim county border. In this regard any planned works along the haulage route should be determined and as the route is along the National Road network the TII is the appropriate authority for agreeing upgrade works along the National Road infrastructure.

I can advise that an application has been recently submitted under planning reference no. 26/61265 for proposed works to facilitate the delivery of turbine components to the permitted Oweninny wind farm phase 3 (ref. no. pa16.316178) in Co. Mayo. The turbine delivery route (TDR) will originate at the port of entry at Killybegs harbour, Co. Donegal, run through Co. Sligo, Co. Leitrim and terminate at the consented Oweninny wind farm phase 3 site, Co. Mayo with a due date of 1st September 26. This application may present an opportunity to co-ordinate any proposed upgrade works to the National Road network.

I trust this has been of assistance.

On behalf of the applicant, RWE Renewables (Ireland) Ltd, Unit 5 Desart House, Lower New Street, Kilkenny City, R95 H488, please find attached a formal cover letter and notification regarding a Planning Application for Strategic Infrastructure Development (SID) which is being submitted to An Coimisiún Pleanála. The proposed development will consist of a 13-turbine wind farm development, with an associated 110 kV substation, battery energy storage system (BESS), and all associated works on land within the townlands of Muingmore (An Mhoing Mhór), Doolough (Dumha Locha), Tristia (Troiste), Moneynierin (Moing an Iarainn) and Bangor (Baingear), County Mayo.

This application is a resubmission of a previously submitted SID application (submitted on 22 May 2026), which was subsequently withdrawn due to a minor clerical error in the site notice. The application is being resubmitted, with updated public consultation dates as set out below.

Pursuant to Section 37E(3)(c) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), a copy of the planning application and associated documents are provided, as agreed, via the designated website which can be viewed at: www.muingmoresid.ie for your information.

This SID application follows on from the completion of a pre-application consultation process with An Coimisiún Pleanála by RWE Renewables (Ireland) Ltd (Ref: ABP-318372-23) and subsequent closure of this process which confirmed that the development constitutes Strategic Infrastructure Development. A copy of the associated SID pre-application determination is also enclosed with the application.

The public notices state that any submissions/observations must be made to the Commission not later than 5.30pm on the 7th of August 2026.
