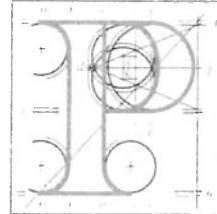

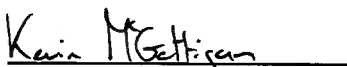

Re: Formal Objection to the Proposed Greenway in Mayasta.

Dear Planning Officer,

I am writing to formally lodge my opposition to the proposed greenway through Mayasta, Kilrush.

While I understand the intent to expand the recreational infrastructure in Co. Clare, I have serious concerns re the localized impact on the community the environment & local livelihoods. The proposed route directly cuts through active working farms which will restrict livestock movement & disrupt daily farming operations. The layout brings ^{the} public path into close proximity

with private residential properties & dairyyards. This raises privacy concerns for local families. Moyasta has sensitive ecosystems which will be disrupted by the greenway.

I urge CCC to engage in more meaningful consultation with landowners & residents of Moyasta. I welcome a solution that supports local tourism without compromising the privacy, safety & economic survival of our community.
