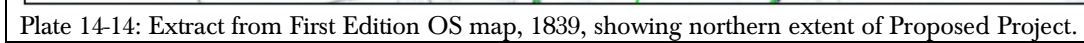


Plate 14-14: Extract from First Edition OS map, 1839, showing northern extent of Proposed Project.

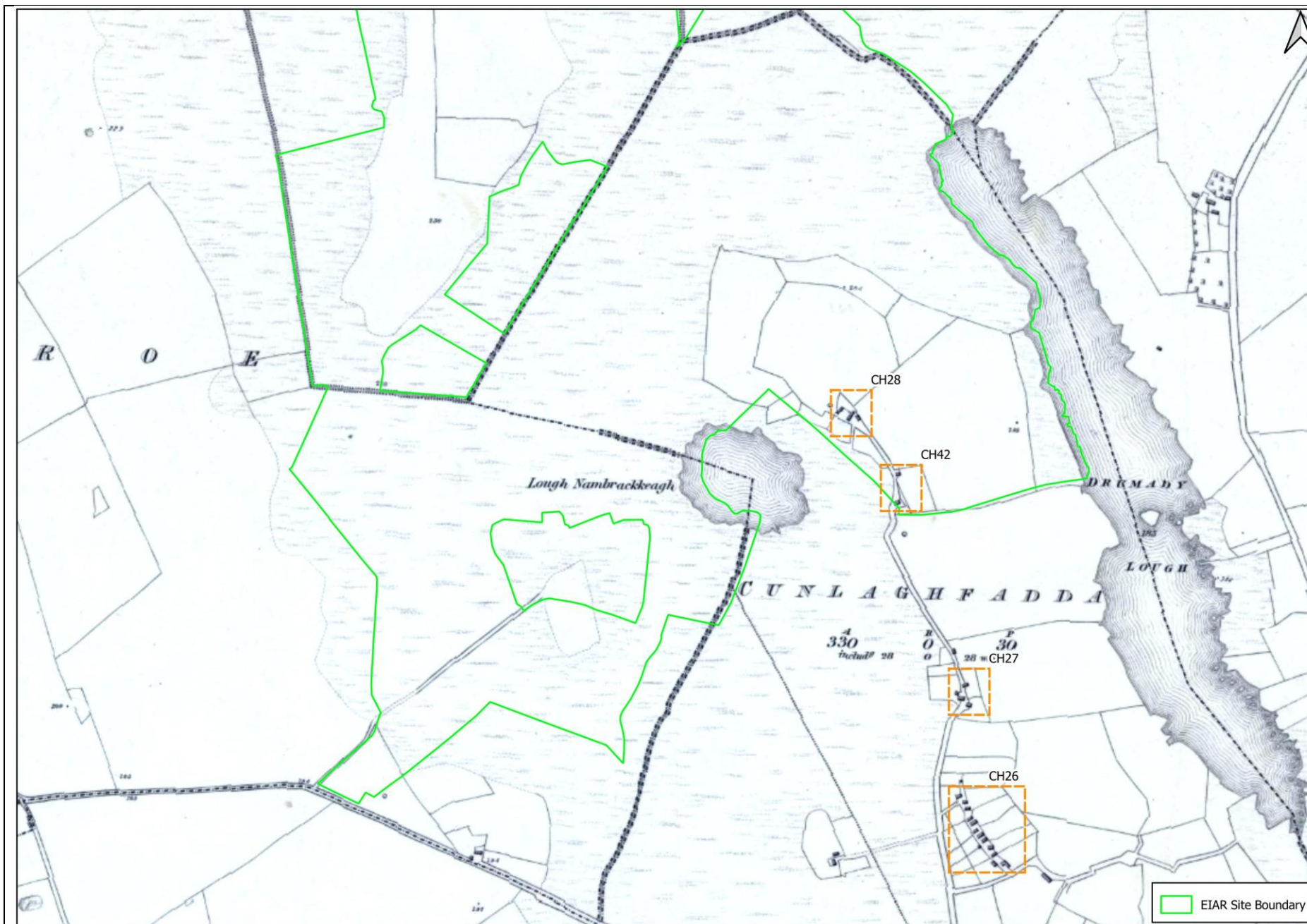


Plate 14-15: Extract from First Edition OS map, 1839, showing southern extent of Proposed Project.

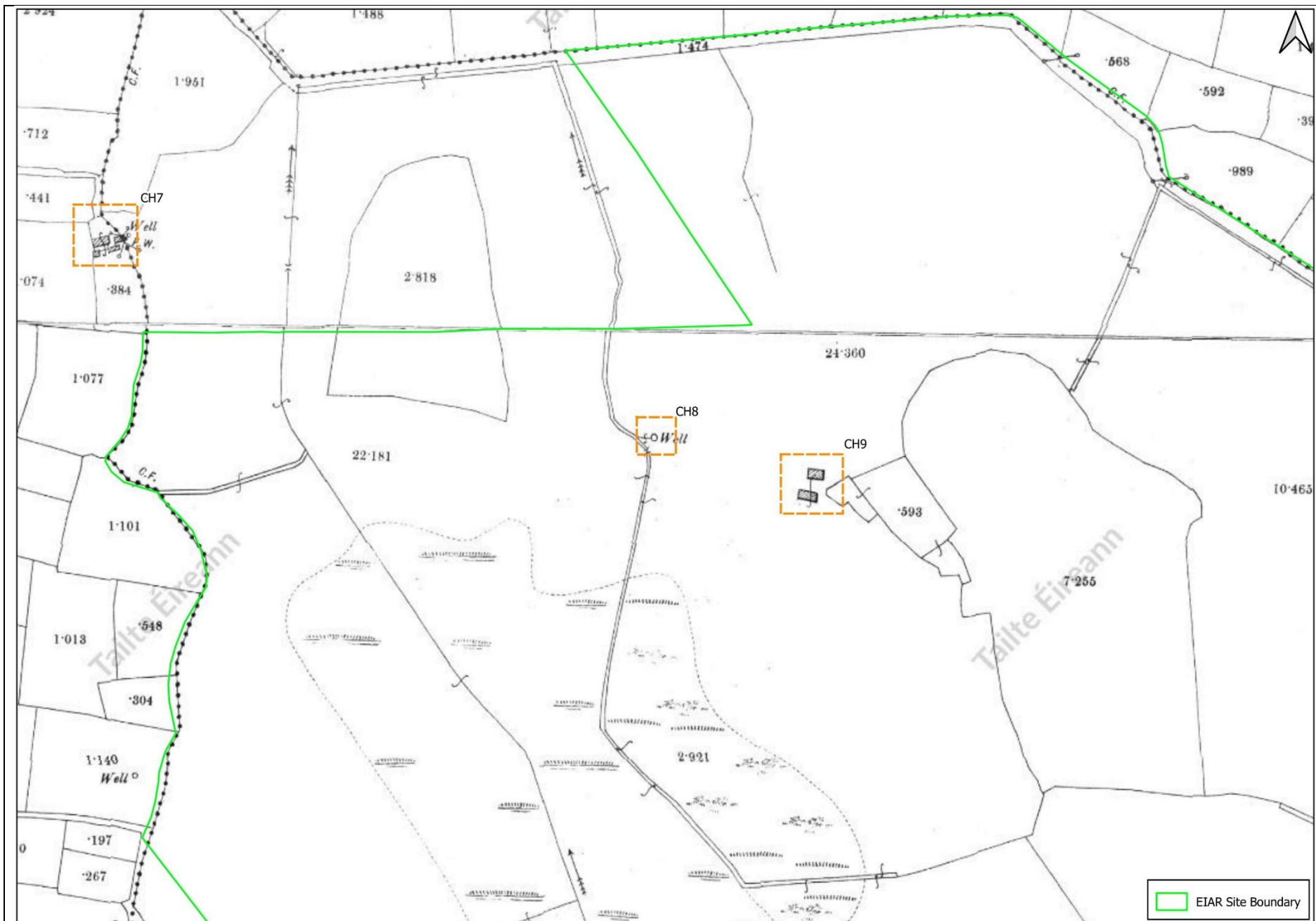


Plate 14-16: Extract from 1896 OS map showing northern extent of Proposed Project.

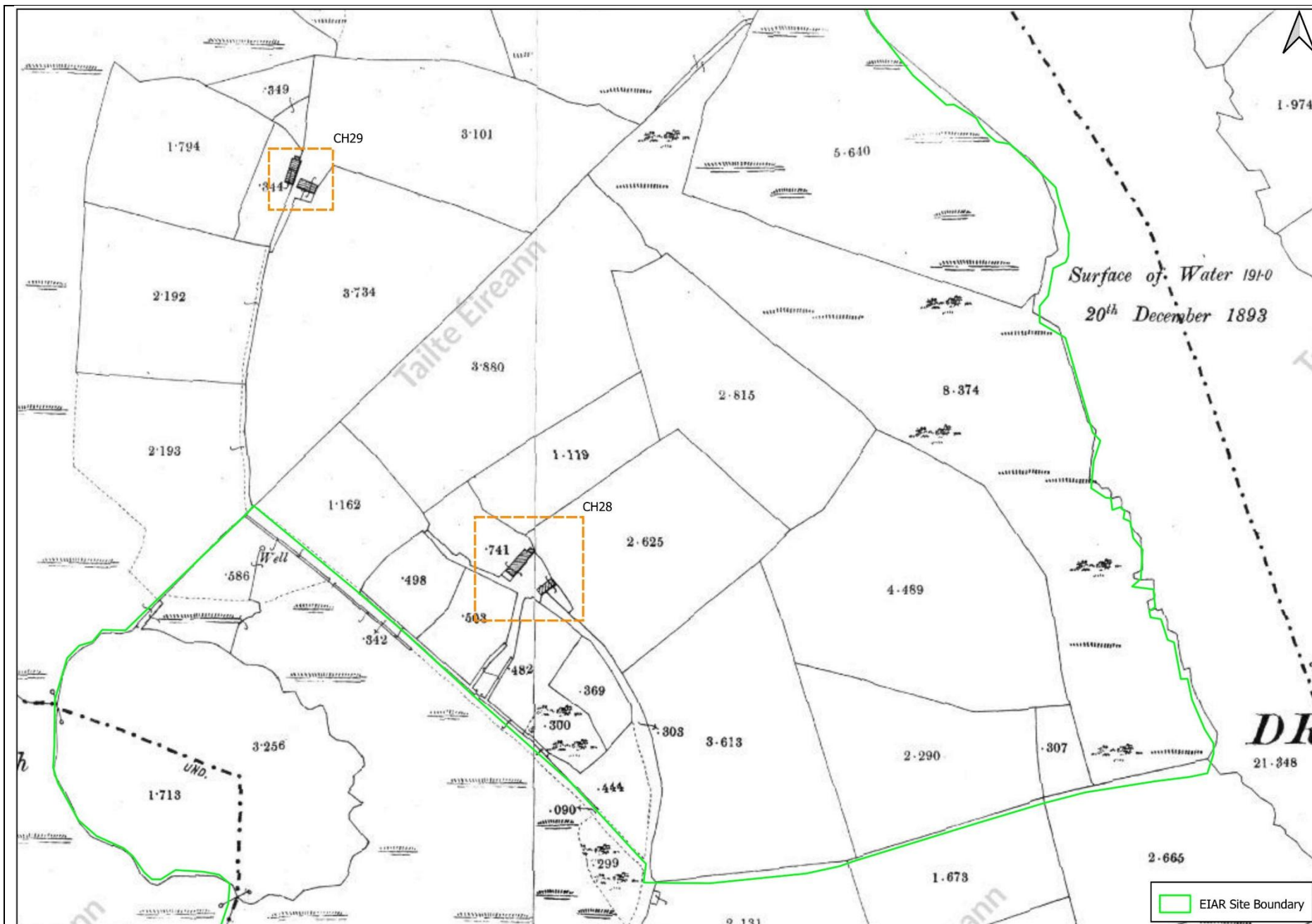


Plate 14-17: Extract from 1896 OS map showing southeast extent of Proposed Project.

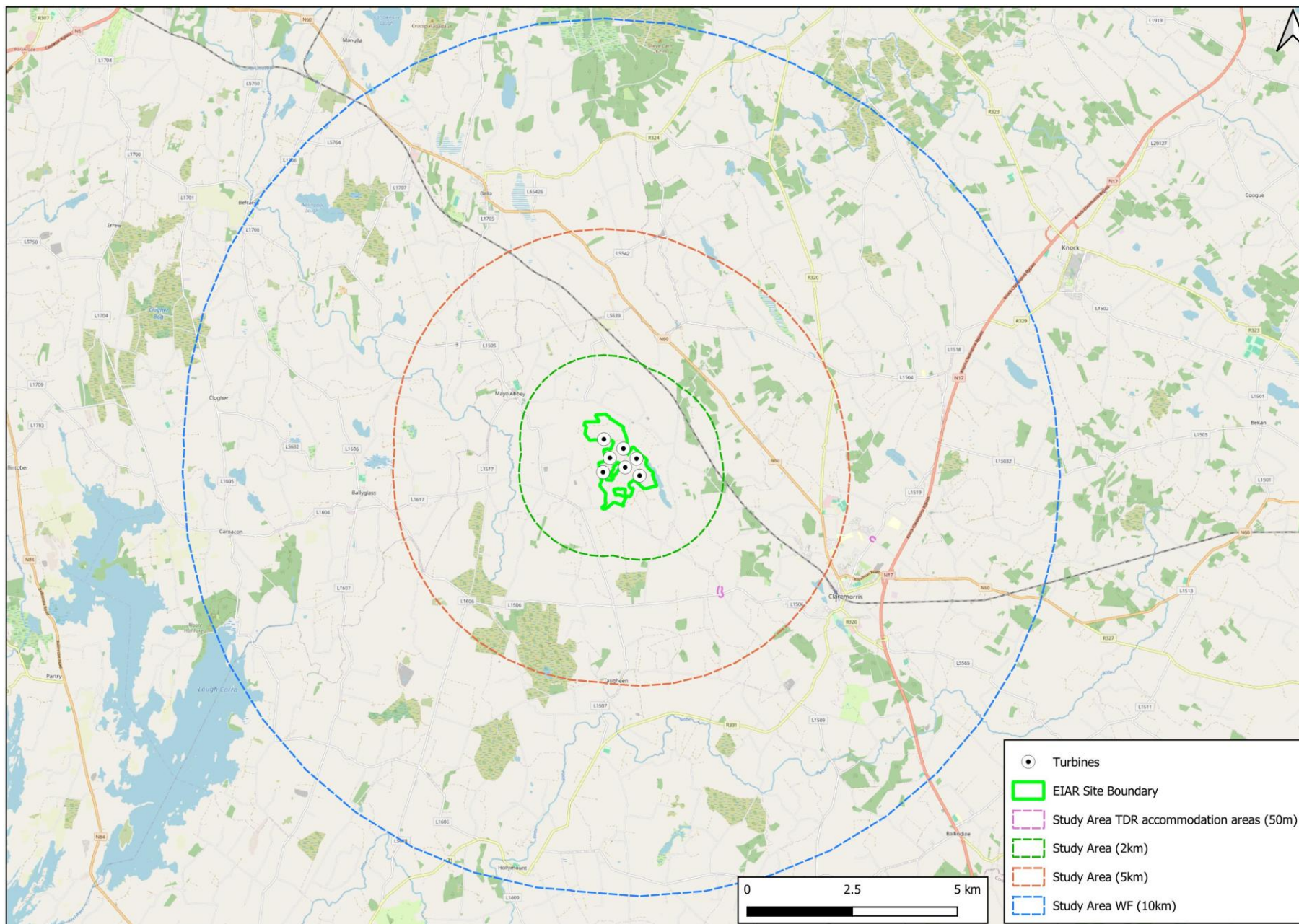


Figure 14-1: Proposed Project, showing study areas

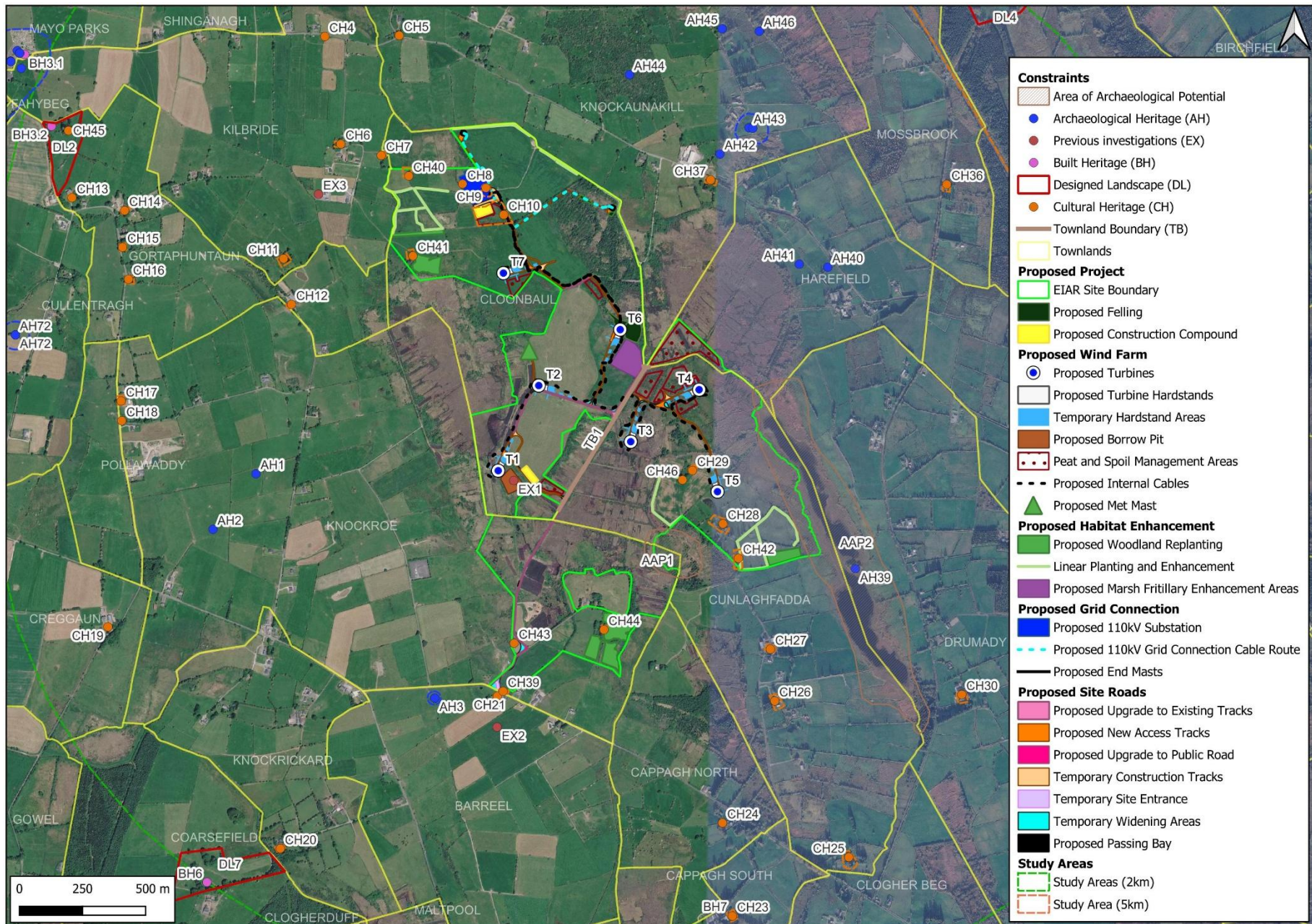


Figure 14-2: Proposed Project and study area, showing archaeological, architectural and cultural heritage receptors.

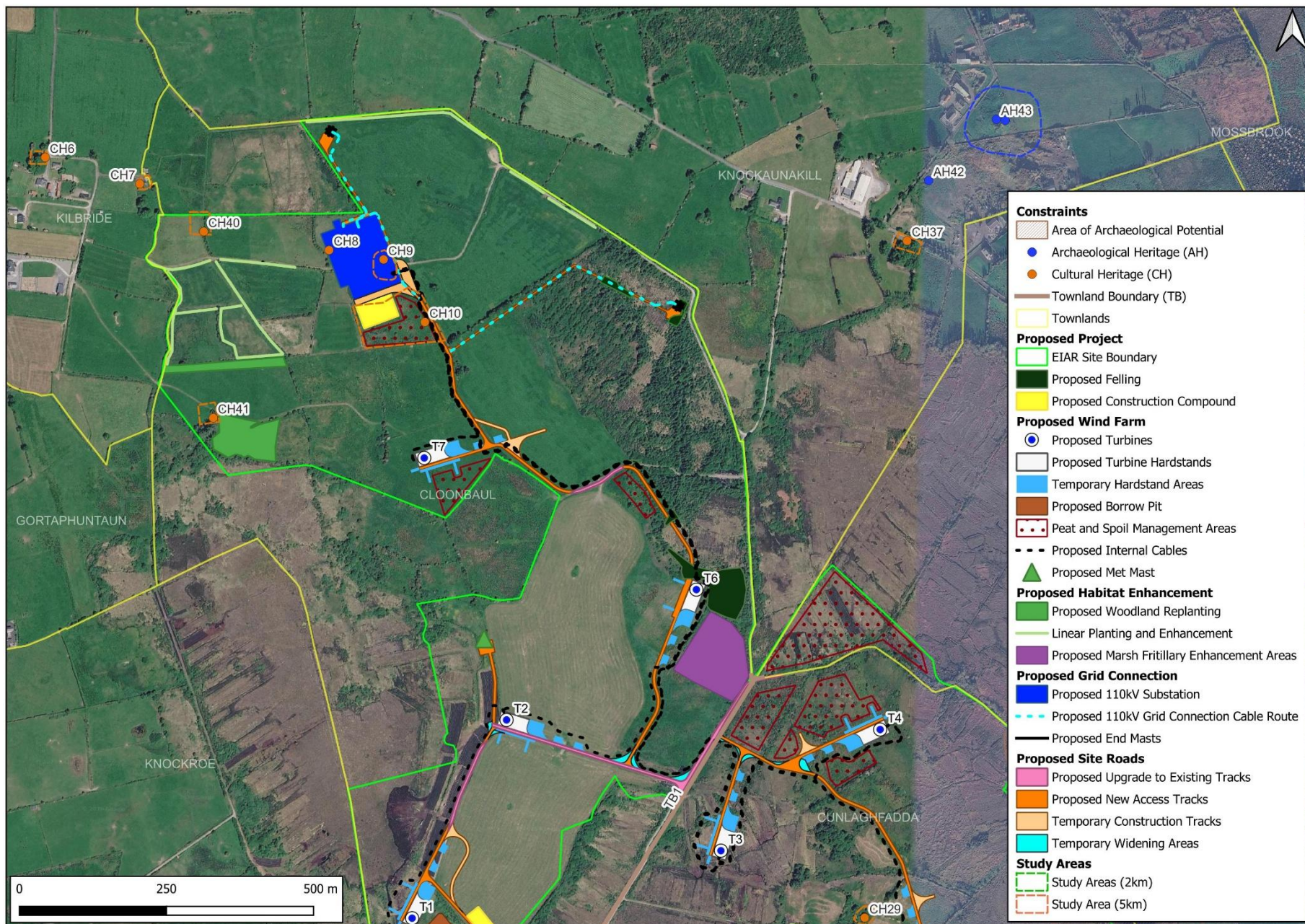


Figure 14-3: Northern half of Site, showing archaeological, architectural and cultural heritage receptors.

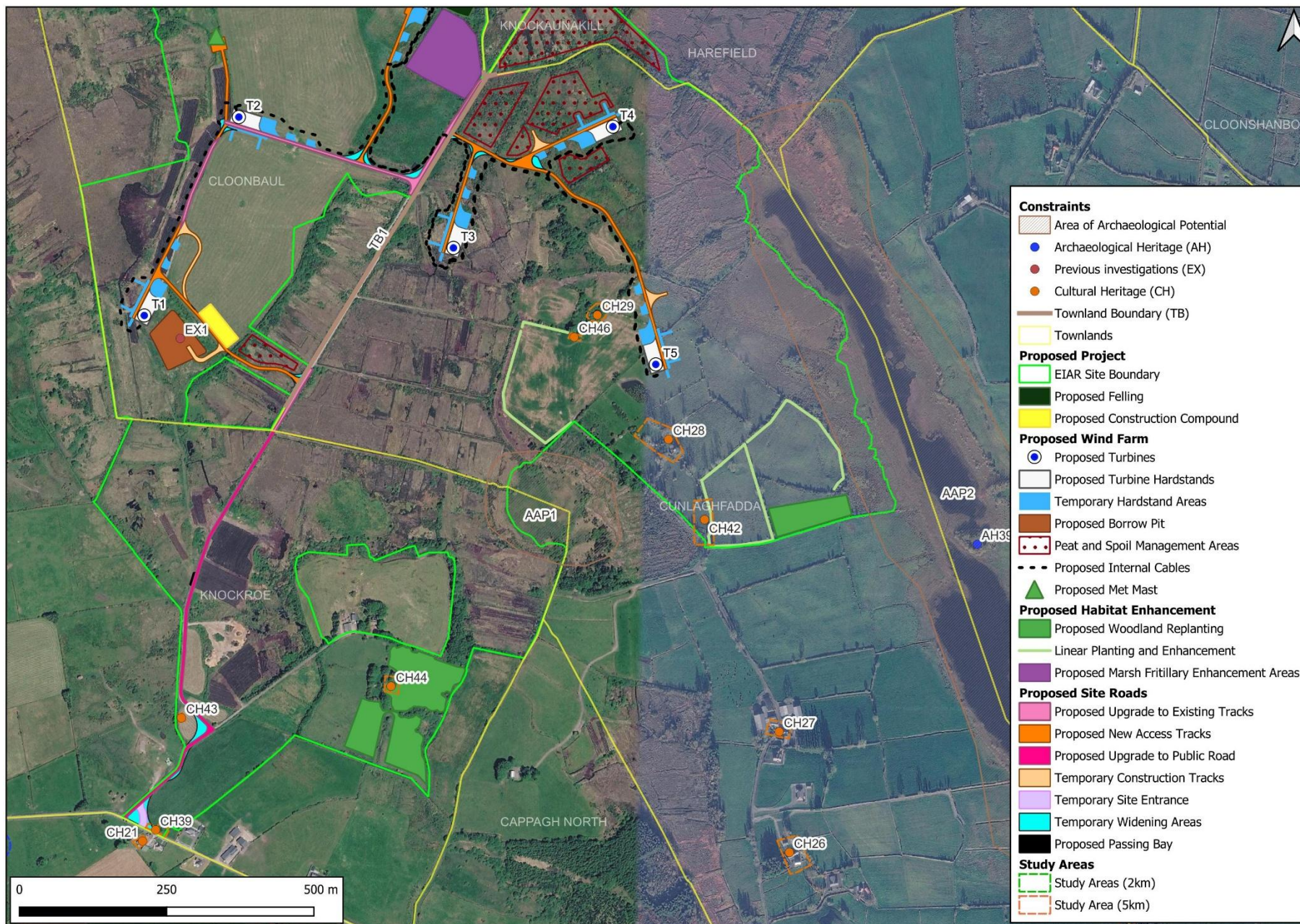


Figure 14-4: Southern half of Site, showing archaeological, architectural and cultural heritage receptors.

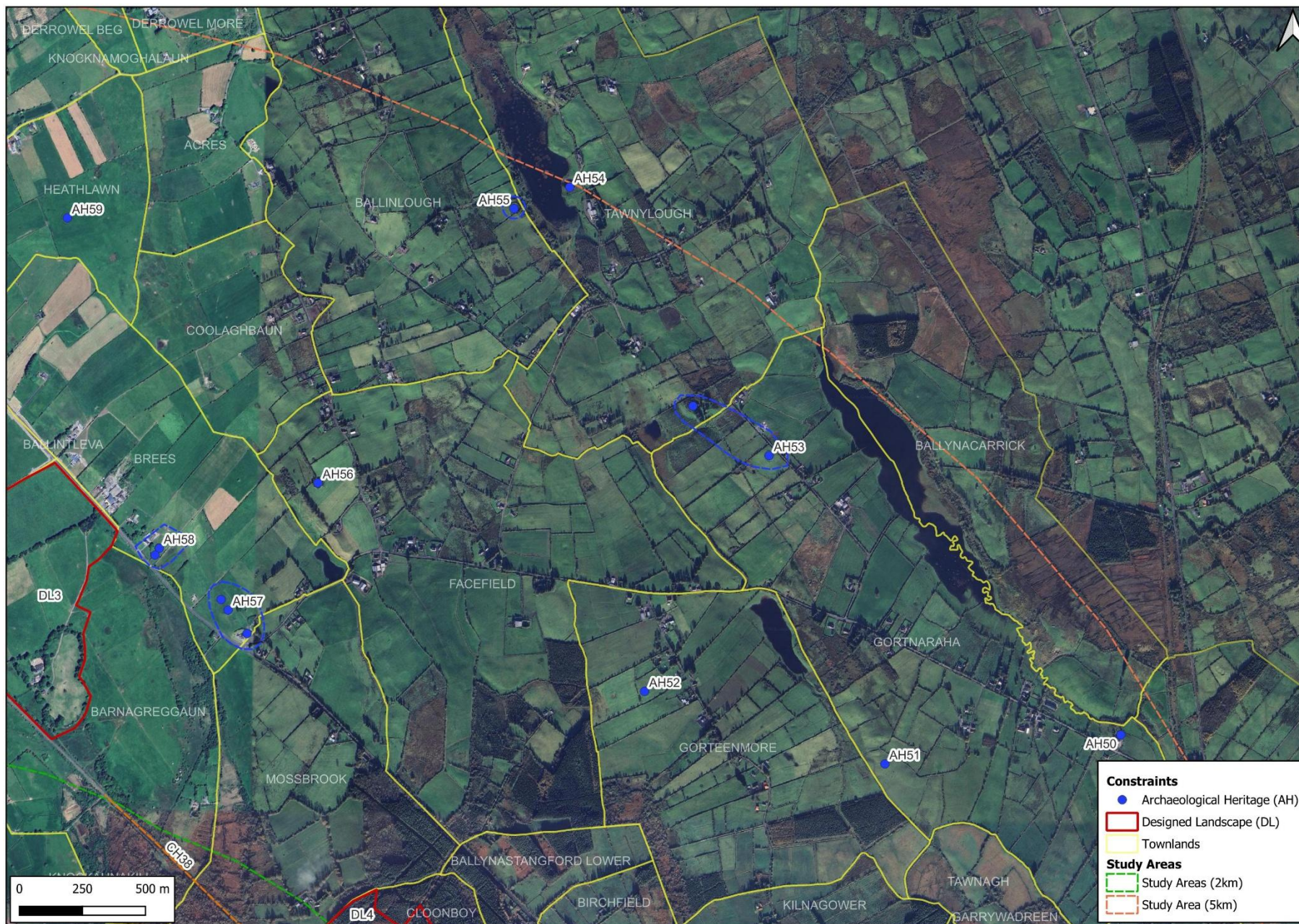


Figure 14-5: Northeast extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

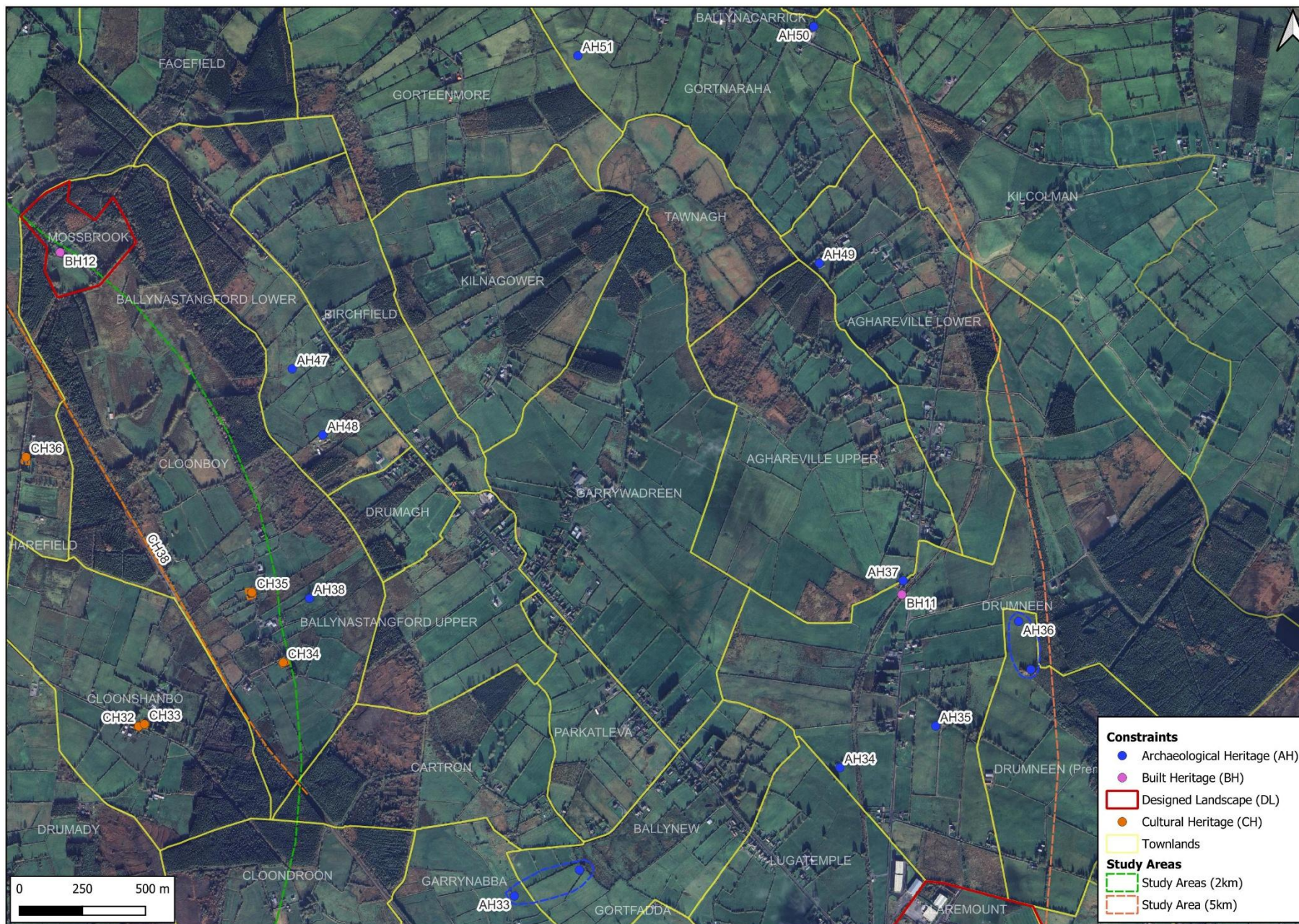


Figure 14-6: East extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

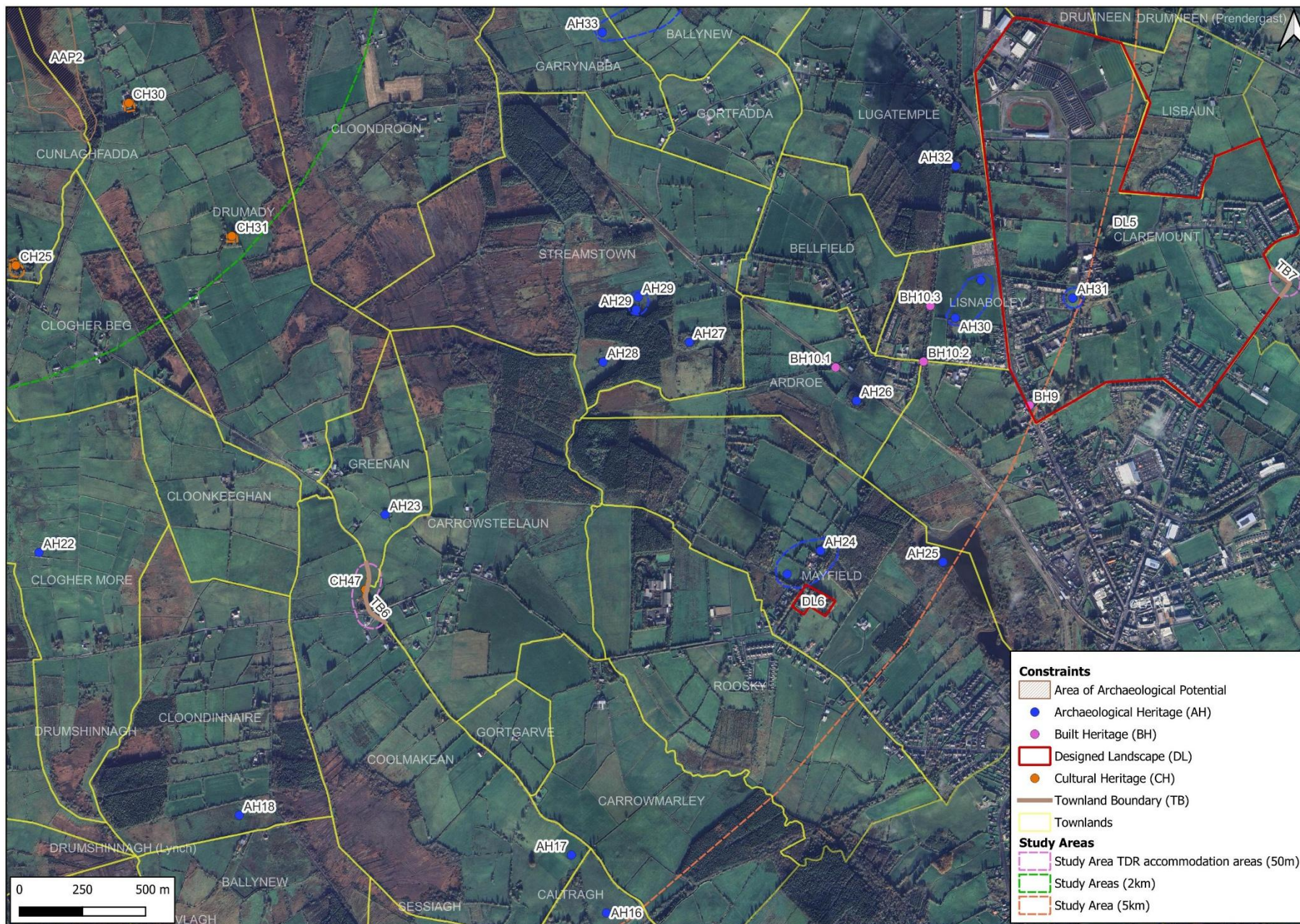


Figure 14-7: Southeast extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

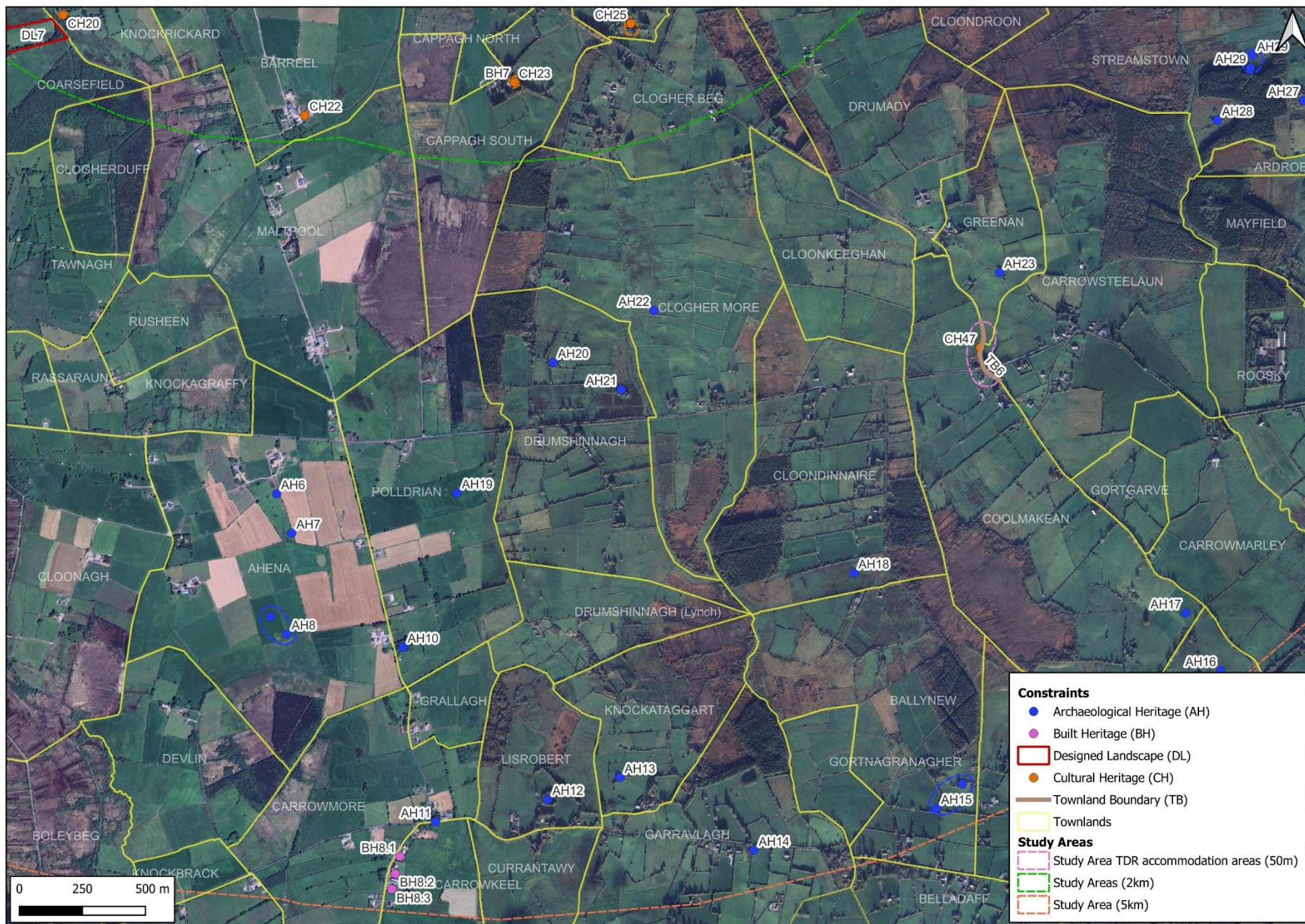


Figure 14-8: South extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

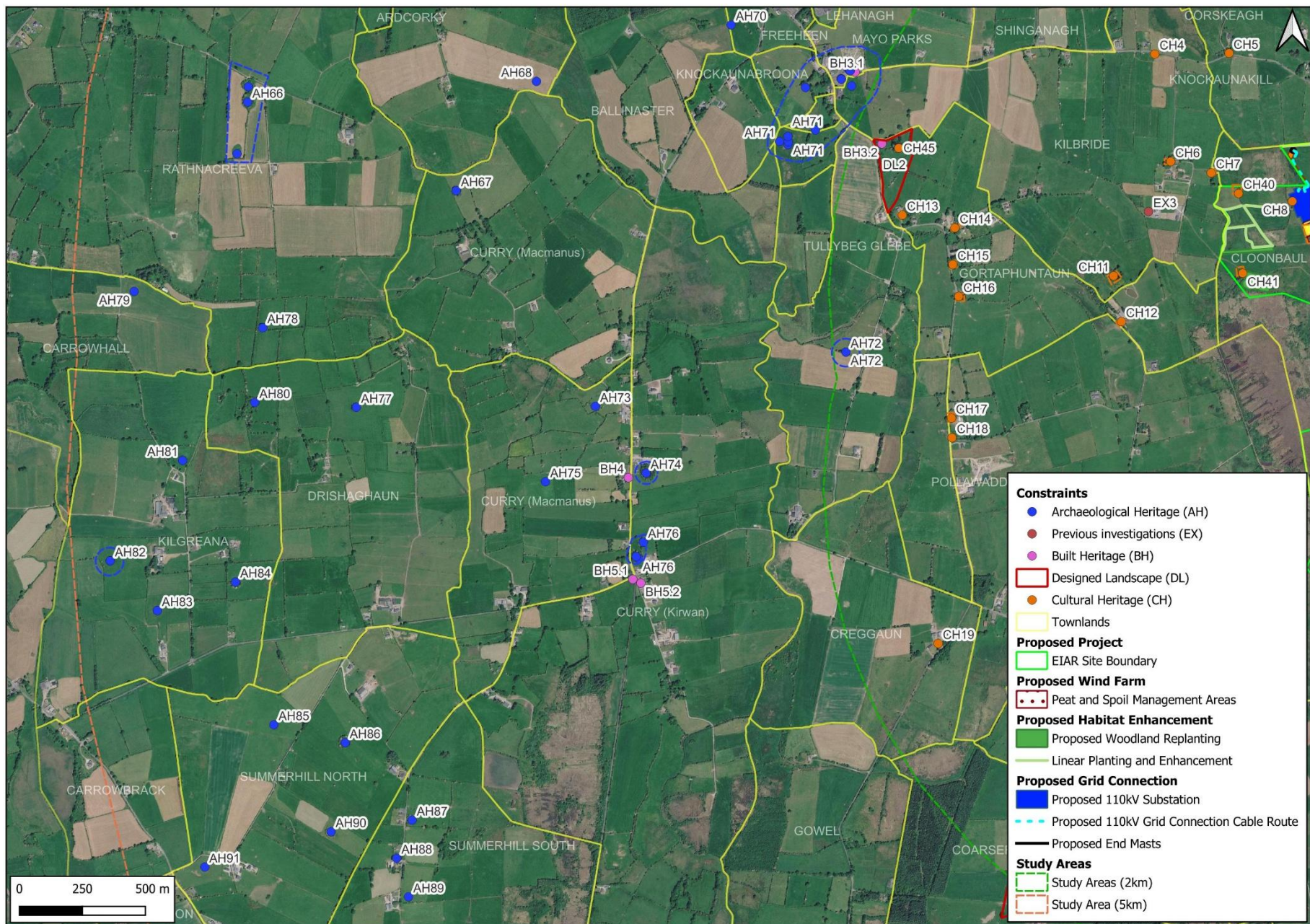


Figure 14-10: Southwest extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

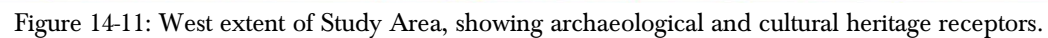


Figure 14-11: West extent of Study Area, showing archaeological and cultural heritage receptors.

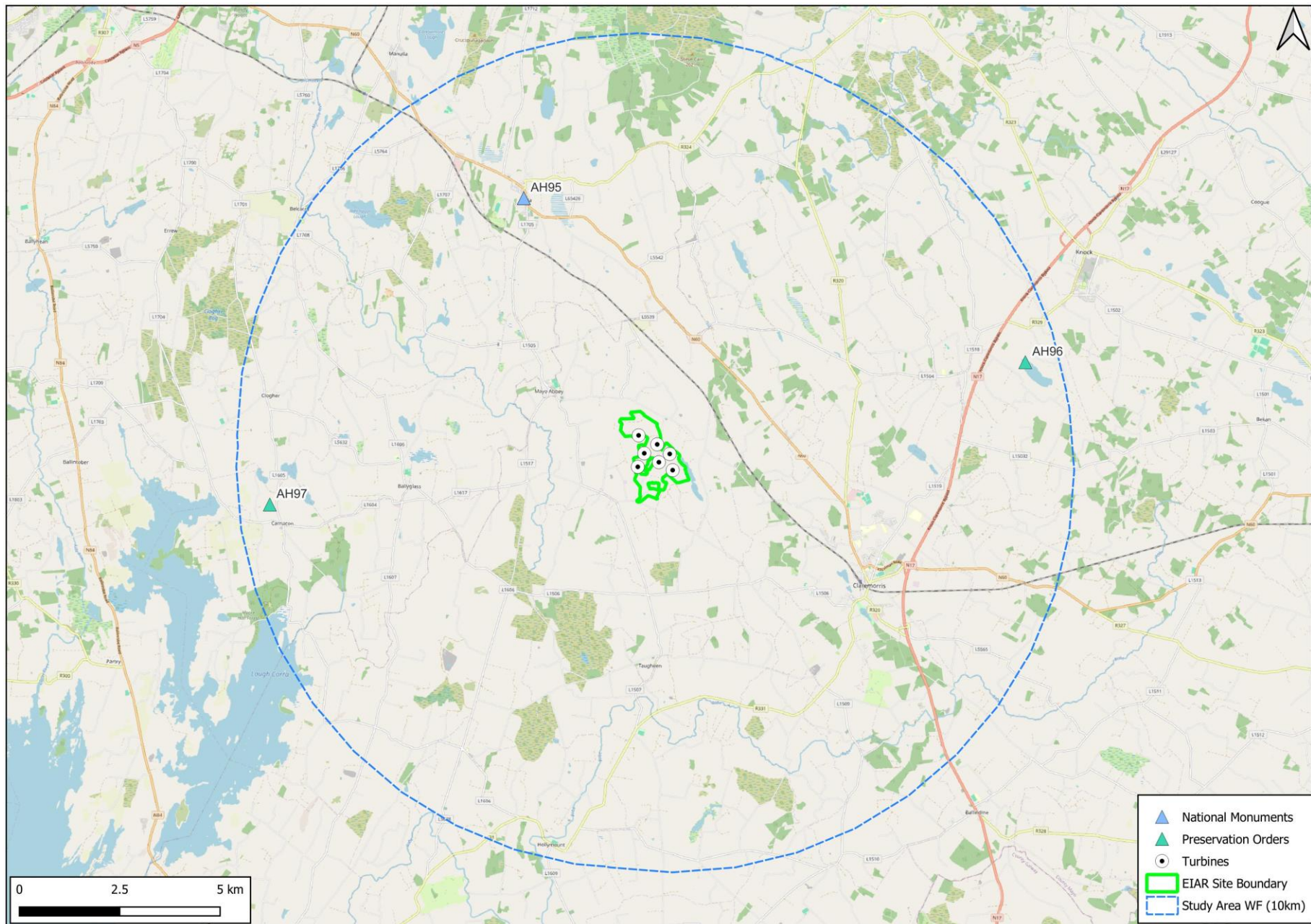


Figure 14-13: National monuments and Preservation Orders within 10km study area.
