It is of concern that every effort should be made to prevent damage to this Recorded Monument, the others historic features, and that there would be an appropriate response should any other previously unrecorded archaeology be discovered during the course of the works. Consequently, the following conditions should be adhered to during the proposed afforestation works:

1. As always, at all times during the proposed afforestation operations the terms of the 'Environmental Requirements for Afforestation' should be adhered to.
