Dear Minister,

An Coimisiún Pleanála has received an application for approval under section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, from FuturEnergy Lissinagroagh DAC of 27/28 Herbert Place, Dublin 2 for the above-mentioned proposed development on the 21st of August 2026.

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed development to which the application for approval relates would be likely to have significant effects on the environment in a transboundary State – *Northern Ireland*.

Location of the land to which application relates: The 110 kV Substation is located in the townland of Faughary, County Leitrim, and a Grid Connection Route spanning across the townlands of Curraghfore, Skreeny, Faughary, Amorset, Clooneen, Milltown, Cornastauk, Srabrick, Cloonaquin, Carrigeencor, Boihy, Aghameelta, Kilcoosy, Corrudda, Cleen, Tully, Killeen, Killanummery, Cleighran, Fawn,

Drumahaire, Drumlease, and Carrowcrin, Co. Leitrim and Lavally, Drumee, and Ballysumaghan, County Sligo.

Description of proposed development: 110kV substation and a 110kV grid connection route to facilitate Lissinagroagh Wind Farm
