

● **Derrynadaragh wind farm objection**

- I object to the water level in our area rising, affecting drains on the roads in the surrounding areas causing more flooding than what already exists, sourage and septic tanks.
- There will be a lot of road closures affecting commute times for residents in the area. This will cost people a lot more expensense in fuel and time during the current fuel crisis. This will also cause residents a lot more stress and anxiety due to longer hours and the factors above.
- Residents will no longer be able to walk around the area due to the much higher volume of traffic and rising water levels during winter times.
- People are concerned about the affects this will have on wildlife in the area and no one can predict what this might be.
- The diversion routes outlined are high traffic areas during the morning time and are not a direct route to most people's place of work in the area.

- If people are forced to reverse for larger vehicles this will cause tail backs and people could be stuck in drains either side of the roads will lead to cars needing recovered in tight areas.
- In the case of an emergency for any resident response time will be a lot slower due to the roads being closed and high traffic volume.
