Galway County Council has submitted to the Board the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (formally referred to as an Environmental Impact Statement) prepared in accordance with Section 50 of the Roads Act 1993 (as amended by section 9(1)(d) of the Roads Act 2007) and Directive 2011/92/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 December 2011 on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014, in respect of the proposed road development. A Natura Impact Statement has also been prepared and has been submitted to the Board in respect of the proposed road development.
