Harrington reacts after semi-final

Dublin fighter will face Thai opponent in the gold medal bout tomorrow

Ireland's Kellie Harrington took another step closer towards emulating five times world champion Katie Taylor with a unanimous 5-0 win in her semi-final in New Delhi, India yesterday.

Dubliner Harrington, who dropped from light-welterweight to the 60kg division, won her semi-final against Kazakhstan's Karina Dbragimova with an aggressive, offensive

bout against her rangy southern opponent.

Dbragimova, fighting from distance, tried to keep the Irish boxer out of reach with her long right jab. But Harrington fought hard to land scoring combinations and each time the Kazak scored the Irish fighter countered.

Awkward
Well prepared for the awkwardly prepared by coach Zane Antia, Harrington's first three-punch volley arrived early in the first round and while Dbragimova was scoring it was Harrington who was showing the more aggression and willingness to go forward.

Backing the first up with a busy second, patience also played its part as Harrington's final round performance was impressive. The Irish fighter who first won world gold in 2006, Harrington's first three world gold medals in the final and a chance to win a gold medal count to 10.

In accordance with Section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) Airdreoro Windfarm Ltd gives notice of its intention to make an application to the Board Pleanála in relation to the following proposed development in the townlands of Airdreoro, Letter, and Fionnán, County Galway. The site is located within a Gaelleachta Area.

The proposed development will constitute the provision of the following:

- i. Construction of up to 25 No. wind turbines with a maximum overall blade tip height of up to 178.5m
- ii. 1 no permanent Meteorological Mast with a maximum height of up to 112 metres.
- iii. 1no. 110kV electrical substation with 2 no. control buildings with welfare facilities, fencing, all associated underground cabling, waste water holding tank and all ancillary works
- iv. Underground cabling connecting the turbines to the proposed substation and connection from the proposed substation to the national grid at the existing Eirgrid substation in the townland of Letter
- v. Upgrade of existing tracks, roads and provision of new site access roads and hardstand areas:
- vi. 3 no. borrow pits
- vii. 2 no. temporary construction compounds.
- viii. Recreation and amenity works, including marked trails, commission of one temporary construction compound into a permanent amenity car park, provision of a toilet/shelter building and associated waste water holding tank, and associated recreation and amenity signage
- ix. Site Drainage.
- x. Forestry Felling.
- xi. Permanent Signage.
- xii. All associated site development works.

This application is seeking a ten year planning permission and 30 year operational life from the date of commissioning of the entire wind farm

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIA) and Natura Impact Statement (NIS) have been prepared in respect of the proposed development.

The planning application, EIA and NIS may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (which fee shall not exceed the reasonable cost of making such a copy) during public opening hours for a period of seven weeks commencing on the 30 November 2018 at the following locations:

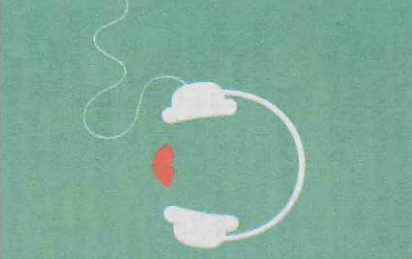
