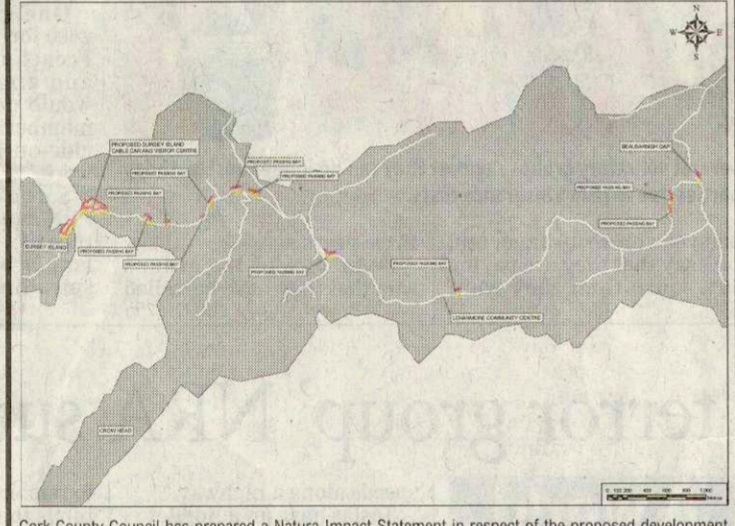

Variable Message Signs (VMS) along the approach roads to the site (1- Bealbanish Gap; 2- the R672 at Castletoynbere; 3- the R575 at Eyeries Cross; and 4- the N71 at Glengarriff), retention of the carrier cabin, mainland-side pylon and a section of the mainland-side hauling machinery of the existing cableway in order to facilitate ongoing appreciation of their industrial architectural and cultural heritage value, soft and hard landscaping and all other ancillary works.
