**Existing Tree**  
To be protected, retained and incorporated into landscape

**Existing Woodland**  
To be protected, retained and incorporated into landscape scheme.

**Large Tree Planting**  
To be planted in 10m, 3m, 4-6m high, 1m clear stem. To be of the following species:  
Aesculus hippocastanum (Horse Chestnut)  
Fagus sylvatica (Beech)  
Quercus robur (Oak)  
Taxus platyphyllos (Lime)

**Medium Sized Street Tree Planting**  
To be planted as 10-12m high specimens with underground guying support. To be selected from following:  
Malus trilobata (Fruit Maple)  
Prunus avium (Wild Cherry)  
Prunus cerasioides (Ornamental Pear)  
Prunus kanzan (Ornamental Cherry)  
Sorbus intermedia (Strawberry Tree)

**Ornamental/Multi-stemmed Tree Planting**  
To be planted as 4-6m, 3m, 4-6m high, 2m clear stem. To be of the following species:  
Aesculus hippocastanum (Horse Chestnut)  
Fagus sylvatica (Beech)  
Quercus robur (Oak)  
Taxus platyphyllos (Lime)

**Existing Native Hedgerow Planting**  
To be retained and enclosed with reference to aboat's report

**Proposed Native Woodland Planting Mix**  
To be planted as 20% 8-10m high standards and 80% saplings. To be of the following species:  
Corylus avellana (Hazel)  
Prunus spinosa (Blackthorn)  
Quercus robur (Oak)  
Taxus platyphyllos (Lime)

**Formal Hedge Planting**  
To be selected from following:  
Carpinus betulus  
Cotoneaster lacteus  
Fagus sylvatica  
Prunus laurocerasus

**Shrub Planting**  
To be selected from following:  
Aster sp. (Aster)  
Buxus sempervirens (Box)  
Celastrus scandens (Witch Hazel)  
Cornus alba 'Solan' (Red Barbed Dogwood)  
Corydalis (Witch's Butter)  
Hypericum 'Velutina' (St. John's Wort)  
Ilex aquifolium (Holly)  
Ligustrum japonicum (Japanese Privet)  
Ligustrum vulgare (Common Privet)
