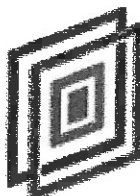

Chapter 7 of the 'EIAR Volume 2: Main Report', 'Soils, Geology and Hydrogeology', makes use of the datasets we have and uses them appropriately. However, any maps used, such as the bedrock, quaternary and aquifer maps should be attributed correctly to Geological Survey Ireland. Page 20, from Chapter 1 of the 'EIAR Volume 2: Main Report', references our previous correspondence sent to RPS on 22 May 2017 and provides the general content of what was included.
