The construction of an 110kV electrical substation, in the townland of Mounthphillips, near Newport County Tipperary and underground 110kV electrical cables and associated communications cables from the proposed substation in Mounthphillips, to the already consented (but not constructed) Upperchurch Windfarm 110kV electrical substation, at Knockcurraghola Commons, near Upperchurch County Tipperary. The underground cabling is proposed for a route through the townlands (west to east) of Mounthphillips / Coole / Freagh / Foidlarrig / Oakhampton / Rockvale / Mackney (O'Brien) / Mackney (Bourke) / Ahane / Newross / Castlewall / Carrowkeale / Tullow / Coolridisla / Derrykeel / Kilnacappagh / Scraggen / Derrygreen / Inchadrinagh / Knockcullenagh / Panit / Lackamore / Tooreenbrien Upper / Tooreenbrien Lower / Readnogy Beg / Readnogy More / Shanballyedmond / Baunadomeeny / Coonmore / Foidlarragh / Kilcomon / Loughbrack / Knockmabansa / Knockmaroe / Knockcurraghola Commons / Knockcurraghola Commons, all in the County of Tipperary.

The proposed 110kV electrical substation in Mounthphillips Townland (Mounthphillips Substation Site) consists of:

- 1 no. electrical substation compound and palisade fencing, measuring 98m x 105m;
- 1 no. electrical substation control building measuring 25m x 15m and 8m in height;
- 6 no. lightning protection monopoles measuring up to 18m in height;
- Associated electrical apparatus, plant and equipment; overhead and underground electrical and communications cabling and ancillary works;
- Permanent widening of 1 no. existing farm entrance;
- 480m of permanent access road measuring 4.5m in width;
- 2 no. end masts measuring up to 16m in height;
- Temporary access road to end masts;
- 1 no. temporary construction compound;
- 1 no. temporary and 2 no. permanent watercourse crossings;
- Temporary and permanent drainage systems; and
- ancillary works.

The proposed underground cabling (110kV UGC) from the proposed substation in Mounthphillips townland to the already consented Upperchurch Windfarm Substation in Knockcurraghola Commons consists of:

- 30.5km of underground 110kV electrical cables and associated communications cables;
- 42 no. underground joint bays;
- replacing 13 no. existing watercourse culverts;
- raising road level and parapet walls heights at 3 no. bridges; and
- ancillary works.

It is proposed that the appropriate period during which the permission (if granted) is to have effect be varied from 5 years to 10 years, having regard to the nature and extent of this development.
