Statue's head goes missing

THE head on a 19th-century statue of a former archbishop in Thurles has been stolen, leaving residents of the town dumbfounded.

The memorial to the late Archbishop of Cashel and Emly, Patrick Leahy, had stood for more than a century outside the doors of Thurles cathedral and is a noted landmark in the town. The head was knocked off sometime between the late Wednesday night and Thursday morning of last week, spreading fragments of stone around the base.

"The statue is part of the fabric of Thurles, it's been there for so long," said Supt Pat Murphy, who is leading the investigation.

Archbishop Kieran O'Reilly expressed the hope that the statue would be restored as soon as possible.
