Maintenance Dredging will be taking place in Cork Harbour on all main shipping channels and berths, commencing 19th August 2020.

Dredging is a necessary process undertaken periodically in the Port of Cork with a major campaign scheduled at three yearly intervals to remove sediment and natural deposition on the river bed. Dredging is required to maintain the required depth for commercial and other vessels navigating the waters of Cork Harbour.

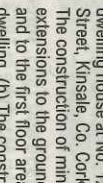

Application to An Bord Pleanála for Substitute Consent Cleenah Windfarm Ltd. intend to apply for substitute consent for a wind farm in the townlands of Peannanree, Cloontycarthy, Cleenah North, Derrineagh, Cleenah South, Milmorane, Coomblane, Rathgashig, Augers, Gortearakilla, Carrigadoura, Gurteenowen, Gurteenlough, Lyrengeetha and Lackabawn, Co. Cork. Leave to Apply for substitute consent in relation to this development was granted by An Bord Pleanála under ABP-306272-19. This application is made pursuant to section 177E(2A)(a) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended). The development for which substitute consent is being sought consists of a wind farm with an operational life of 25 years from the date of commissioning and constitutes the following:

- 9 No. wind turbines with a ground to blade tip height of 150 metres and all associated foundations and hard-standing areas.
- All associated underground electrical (33kV & 38kV) and communications cabling connecting the turbines to the national electricity grid.
- Upgrade of existing access junctions and roads.
- Upgrade of existing and provision of new site access roads.
- Borrow pit.
- Temporary construction compound.
- Accommodation works along the turbine delivery route.
- Temporary roadway to facilitate turbine delivery.
- Forestry Felling.
- Site Drainage.
- The operation of the wind farm for a period of 25 years.
- The decommissioning of the wind farm, removal of turbines and restoration of the site.
- All associated site development and ancillary works.

The application for substitute consent is accompanied by a Remedial Environmental Impact Assessment (REIAR) and a Remedial Natural Impact Statement (NIS) in relation to the works that have been carried out pursuant to ABP PL 04.246742. The application for substitute consent is also accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIRAR) and a Natural Impact Statement (NIS) in relation to that part of the development that has not been carried out pursuant to ABP PL 04.246742 at the time of this application, this includes the operation of the wind farm and its decommissioning. Submissions or observations may be made on the application, including the REIAR, NIS, EIRAR and NIS to An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, without charge. Submissions or observations must be in writing and made within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt of the application by An Bord Pleanála and such submissions and observations will be considered by An Bord Pleanála in making a decision on the application.
