- LANDSCAPE NOTES:**
1. ALL PLANTS ARE TO BE OF HEALTHY STOCK AND PRODUCED LOCALLY WHERE POSSIBLE
 2. ALL PLANT FAILURES ARE TO BE REPLACED WITH IN THE FIRST PLANTING SEASON
 3. TOP SOIL TO BE OF GOOD QUALITY ENRICHED WITH ORGANIC MATTER.
 4. LAWNS TO HAVE A MINIMUM OF 200MM OF TOP SOIL OVER 300MM OF SUB SOIL.
 5. SHRUB AREAS ARE TO HAVE A MINIMUM OF 450MM TOP SOIL.
 6. TREE PITS ARE TO BE .900MM * 900MM LOSE FORKED WITH FREE DRAINING GRANULAR STONE .100 DEEP TO THE BASE. WHERE TREES ARE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO SERVICES AND BUILDINGS ROOT BARRIER MEMBRANE IS TO BE USED TO PROTECT STRUCTURES
 7. ALL TREES ARE TO BE STAKED AND TIED WITH RABBIT PROTECTION GUARDS FITTED.
 8. WILDFLOWER MEADOW SEED TO BE NATIVE SPECIES WITH NATIVE PROVINANCE
 9. ALL LANDSCAPE WORKS SHOULD BE CARRIED OUT BY QUALIFIED LANDSCAPE CONTRACTORS TO ENSURE THE STANDARD OF WORKS COMPLY WITH BEST WORKS PRACTICE.
