Application to An Bord Pleanála for permission in relation to a quarry: Section 37L of the Planning and Development Act, 2000: Drimoleague Concrete Works Limited, intends to apply for permission for the further development of Ummera Gravel Pit, Ummera Macroom County Cork. The development covers a total area of 15.5 hectares. consisting of current active extraction areas, yard area and approximately 2 hectares new extraction areas (to the south and eastern margin of current extraction areas); construction of perimeter earthen screening berms; pavement of existing site access road; construction of a bunded fuel storage shed and concrete refueling pad; replacement of the septic tank & percolation area with a sealed wastewater collection tank; continuation of use of existing site infrastructure including site entrance, washing plant, pump house, settlement ponds, site office, stores, storage of aggregate, all associated ancillary infrastructure and restoration of the site to agricultural use.
