This consultation is regarding Barnadivane Wind Farm which is located in the townlands of Lackareagh, Garranereagh and Barnadivane (Kneeves), near Teerelton, Co. Cork.

In December 2014 Barna Wind Energy (BWE) Ltd. submitted an application for the proposed Barnadivane Wind Farm. The planning reference for this application was CCC Pl. Ref. 14/6760. The proposed wind farm comprised 6 turbines with a tip height of 131 m, a meteorological mast, access roads and hardstands, a new access junction and improvements to the public road, a temporary compound, a borrow pit, underground electrical cables and ancillary infrastructure. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was submitted as part of the application. The applicant received a grant of permission by Cork County Council and was appealed to An Bord Pleanála (Ref: PL04.245824). The decision was quashed by An Bord Pleanála under appeal in 2016 and 2017, and annulled in 2019 (ABP PL04.248153).

In December 2014, a separate planning application for the proposed substation was submitted to Cork County Council (Pl. Ref. 14/557). A Planning and Environmental Report was submitted as part of the application. The substation was to replace the substation granted under CCC Pl. Ref. 05/5907 which was extended under CCC Pl. Ref.11/6605, and ABP PL04.219620. The decision was quashed by ABP under appeal in 2016 and 2017 (ABP PL04.244439), and annulled in 2019 (ABP PL04.248152).

New appeals were lodged to ABP for the wind farm site (PL04.308210) and the substation (PL04.308208). This EIAR has been produced in response to a request from An Bord Pleanála to provide an updated assessment given the passage of time since the submission of 2014 applications.




