The Greenlink Interconnector will comprise subsea and underground high voltage electricity cables and associated converter stations to connect EirGrid's Great Island 220 kV substation in County Wexford (Ireland) and National Grid's Pembroke transmission substation in Pembrokeshire (Wales).
