Dear Sirs,

We wish to support the objections to the above Planning Application.

Moore Street has a historical concern on at least 3 Fronts;

First is the intrinsic connection to Dubliners as an economic centre offering Hardware Foodstuffs Meat in Pateenach, Flowers etc

Secondly the demolition of existing shops and Buildings flies in the face of urgently needed Homes for the Homeless. Expensive Flats are not a Substitute. There is room for 500 Homes on the site if instead of Demolition Repairs to Existing Buildings were undertaken.

Thirdly this area contains the site where nurse Elizabeth O'Farrell after treating James Connolly and others was asked by the 1916 Leaders to carry a white flag onto the street putting her own life in danger among flying bullets. A Museum will be useless unless the Ambiance of Surrounding properties are maintained.

Please stop this demolition!
