RE: Application under Section 51 of the Roads Act 1993, as amended, for approval of the CLONGRIFFIN TO CITY CENTRE CORE BUS CORRIDOR SCHEME

Dear Sir/Madam,

The National Transport Authority (NTA) are submitting the enclosed Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement for the Clongriffin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme to An Bord Pleanála and are hereby applying for approval under section 51 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, for the purposes of construction and operation of the Clongriffin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme for the purposes of facilitating public transport.

The Clongriffin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme consists of construction of bus, cycle and pedestrian infrastructure. The scheme has an overall length of approximately 5.7km and is routed along the R107 Malahide Road from Mayne River Avenue — R107 Malahide Road junction to the junction with Marino Mart — Fairview and also routed for cyclists via the junction with Malahide Road-Brian Road along Carleton Road, St Aidan's Park, Haverty Road and Marglann Marino all in the County of Dublin.

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report has been prepared and compiled in accordance with the provisions of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended and in accordance with Directive 2011/92/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 December 2011 as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 in respect of the proposed road development. A Natura Impact Statement has also been prepared in respect of the proposed road development.

The National Transport Authority can confirm that the application fee of €60,000 has been paid by Electronic Funds Transfer to the An Bord Pleanála and notification has been sent to <u>finance@pleanala.ie</u> and wishes to advise An Bord Pleanála that a related compulsory purchase order namely 'Clongriffin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme Compulsory Purchase Order 2022' will be lodged in the next number of days and that the NTA will be seeking a fee waiver in relation to that CPO.
