On the 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2022, the Board received a 3<sup>rd</sup> party appeal from Patricia Fuentes and Others against the decision of Louth County Council to grant permission with conditions for the above development (Reg. Ref: 211499). 3 further appeals were also received; on 19<sup>th</sup> April from John McGrane, on 19<sup>th</sup> April from Sean Johnston and on 20<sup>th</sup> April from the Grogan family. These are all 3<sup>rd</sup> party appeals.

The last date for receipt of observations is 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. The last date for receipt of appeal responses is 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. So far no observations or appeal responses have been received.
