In accordance with Section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) Art Data Centres Ltd., gives notice of its intention to make an application for permission/approval to An Bord Pleanda in relation to the proposed development described below.

The proposed development primarily comprises the provision of an entitle Vice involuted Westpear (GIS) grid substation at 10 18 underground transmission cables connecting to existing 10 18 orderground transmission cables connecting to existing the expension of the connecting to the existing frame 110 W underground transmission cable connecting to the existing frame 110 W grid substation (locate to the east of the M18 and to the north of the Tulia fina (R521), along with associated and ancillary works.

The proposed development is located within the townlands of Tooren, Cahernalough, Knockanean, Ballymacahill, Muckinish, and Rosslewan to the north east of Ennis, on the Tulla Road (R352), Co. Clare. The application site has a total area of c. 9.0

The proposed new 110 kV GIS grid substation is to be located on lands at Calierradough, to the north east of Ennis, and to the north of the Tulla Road (R852). The proposed 110 kV GIS grid substation is located to the north east of a proposed data centre development subject to a separate concurrent application.
