In addition the Councillors also agreed to add a number of buildings and parts of buildings to the Council's Record of Protected Structures (RPS). The structures added to the RPS are located at:

- 17-18 Henry Place, Dublin 1
- 10 Moore Street, Dublin 1
- 12 Moore Street, Dublin 1
- 13 Moore Street, Dublin 1
- 20-21 Moore Street, Dublin 1

I am asking ABP to consider the buildings above as being listed on the Record of Protected Structures when determining this appeal. The Planning process is ongoing with this appeal and therefore any additions to the RPS during the planning process must be given due consideration.

With reference to the Dublin City Development Plan 2022-228, I am also asking ABP to take on board the additional references to the buildings and adjoining laneways on Moore Street when determining this appeal. These references included references to a cultural hub and
