The application for substitute consent and accompanying documentation may be inspected, or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, or the Planning Authority, Donegal County Council, County House, The Diamond, Lifford, Co. Donegal, during their public opening hours.
