Re: Section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended - Planning Application to An Bord Pleanála for a Proposed Development in the townlands of Cummeennabuddoge (Co. Kerry) and Caherdowney (Co. Cork)

Dear Sir/Madam,

On behalf of our client, Knocknamork Ltd. please find enclosed a copy of a planning application for development which forms part of grid connection and access arrangements which will facilitate the permitted Knocknamork Renewable Energy Development, Cork County Council Ref. No. 19/4972. Concurrent planning applications in relation to the overall grid connection and access arrangements have been lodged with Cork County Council and Kerry County Council.

This application is being made directly to An Bord Pleanála as 'Strategic Infrastructure Development' (SID) under the provisions of Section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. This position was confirmed by An Bord Pleanála in correspondence to the applicant dated 15th June 2022 following pre-application consultations with the Board (ABP-312249-21 a copy of the noted correspondence is enclosed with this letter for completeness).

The development will consist of the following:

- 110 kV electrical substation with 2 no. control buildings with welfare facilities, all associated electrical plant and apparatus, security fencing, underground cabling, waste water holding tank and all ancillary works;
- ii. Underground electrical cabling (110kV);
- iii. New access roads;
- iv. Borrow pit;
- v. Site Drainage;
- vi. Forestry Felling; and
- vii. All associated site development works and apparatus.

An extended planning permission duration to align with the permitted Knocknamork Renewable Energy Development, Cork County Council Ref. No. 19/4972 is sought.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and Natura Impact Statement (NIS) have been prepared in respect of the proposed development and accompanies this application.

As the project requires an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) the application has been notified to the EIA Portal. The EIA Portal ID is 2022137 and that the project details have been uploaded to the EIA Portal.


All planning drawings are provided at scales which have previously been agreed with An Bord Pleanála.



Please be advised that following consultations under section 182E of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, the Board hereby serves notice that it is of the opinion that the proposed development falls within the scope of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended. Accordingly, the Board has decided that the proposed development would be strategic infrastructure within the meaning of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended. Any application for approval for the proposed development must therefore be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under section 182A(1) of the Act.

Please also be informed that the Board considers that the pre-application consultation process in respect of this proposed development is now closed.
